The Prince William Health District (PWHD), an accredited health department, serves Prince William County and the independent cities of Manassas and Manassas Park. We are one of 35 health agencies operating under the Virginia Department of Health. Public Health is about protecting and improving the health of populations through promotion of healthy lifestyles, disease and injury prevention, and detection and control of infectious diseases. Almost 100 PWHD public health professionals work across the community to improve health and opportunities for our residents.

Our Mission: The Prince William Health District is dedicated to promoting optimum wellness, preventing illness, responding to emergencies and protecting the environment and health of our residents.

Services Provided:

Clinical Services

Our Clinical Team offers services such as our immunization program, sexually transmitted infections/HIV services, health screenings, tuberculosis control program, and newcomer refugee health program. We also make referrals to other systems, programs and clinics when necessary. We work with local health providers and social service departments to ensure that patients receive coordinated care. In addition, we provide preventive health services, such as women's health services, teen wellness, and pregnancy testing.

Communicable Disease Investigation and Surveillance

Our Epidemiology Team performs follow-up investigations on all reportable diseases and investigate outbreaks in the community. The goal is to identify the source of the infection, implement control measures and prevent the spread of disease. We work closely with local health care providers in the community to recommend infection control measures and interventions to prevent future outbreaks.

Environmental Health

Our Environmental Health Team protects public health by preventing the transmission of disease through food, water, and sewage, and works closely with other agencies to protect the environment. We provide services such as animal bites and rabies control, restaurant and food inspections, facility inspections, permits, swimming pool inspections, sewage and water services, etc.

Population Health

We monitor the health status of the community and conduct primary and secondary research on various public health issues. This includes conducting a Community Health Assessment and implementing a Community Health Improvement Plan, with the goal of identifying key public health issues and implementing strategies to create health opportunities for all residents.

Women, Infants and Children (WIC)

Our WIC Team provides supplemental food, health care referrals and nutrition education for low-income pregnant, breastfeeding and non-breastfeeding postpartum women; and to infants and children up to age five who are at nutritional risk. WIC is effective in improving the health of pregnant women, new mothers and their infants.
