WOMEN, INFANTS & CHILDREN (WIC)

WIC improves the health of pregnant women, new mothers and their young children up to age five by providing supplemental food, health care referrals, nutrition counseling and other parenting resources.

VITAL RECORDS

Your Prince William Health District offers marriage, divorce, birth and death certificates that have occurred in the Commonwealth of Virginia. These vital records are only available to family members-mother, father, current spouse, child, brother, sister and grandparents with valid ID.

COMMUNITY HEALTH & CLINICAL SERVICES

Through our Community Health Division, the Prince William Health District encourages healthy habits, investigates disease outbreaks, conducts long-term care screenings and offers preventative healthcare for people living in Greater Prince William – Prince William, Manassas and Manassas Park.



CLINICAL SERVICES & PREVENTATIVE CARE

Health District clinics are not full-service doctor offices. Instead, our skilled staff focuses on prevention within specific areas of expertise:

- **Every Woman's Life:** Free breast & cervical cancer screening
- **Sexually Transmitted Infection:** Testing, treatment & education
- **Immunizations:** Children, teens & adults
- **Tuberculosis:** Screening & treatment
- **Newcomer Health:** Screenings for new arrivals to the U.S.

Many services are provided on a sliding scale, based on income eligibility.

INSPECTIONS & PREVENTION: PROTECTING YOUR HEALTH

The Prince William Health District ensures that our environment, natural and man-made are safe for all who live here. Often working behind the scenes, our Environmental Health Division provides services such as:

- **Food Safety & Restaurant Inspections:** Inspecting cafeterias, daycares, schools, fairs, food trucks, and anywhere food is prepared and served to the public; Investigating foodborne illness complaints
- **Aquatic Health:** Inspecting pools, spas and water parks
- **Vector Borne Disease Control and Prevention:** "Vectors" include mosquitoes, ticks and fleas
- **Animal Bites and Rabies Prevention:** Domestic and Wild animals
- **Sanitation in Public Facilities:** Inspecting hotels, motels, B&B's and campgrounds
- **Water Quality Assurance:** Monitoring of permitted wells, sewage systems and marinas
- **Environmental Complaints & Community Concerns:** Investigating hazardous substances spills, sewage complaints chemical odors and nuisances
