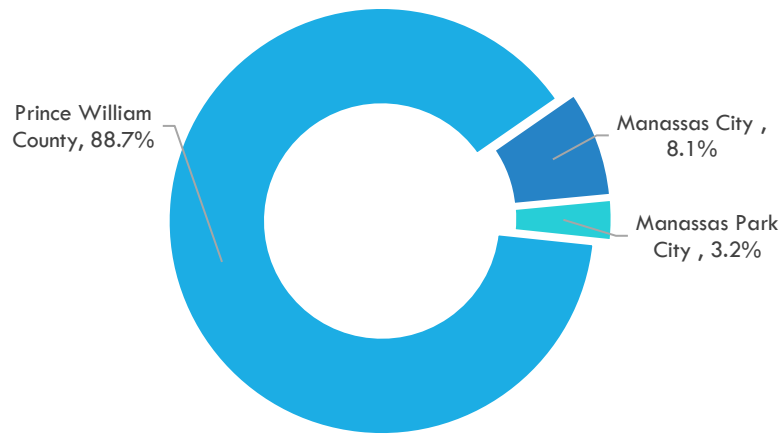

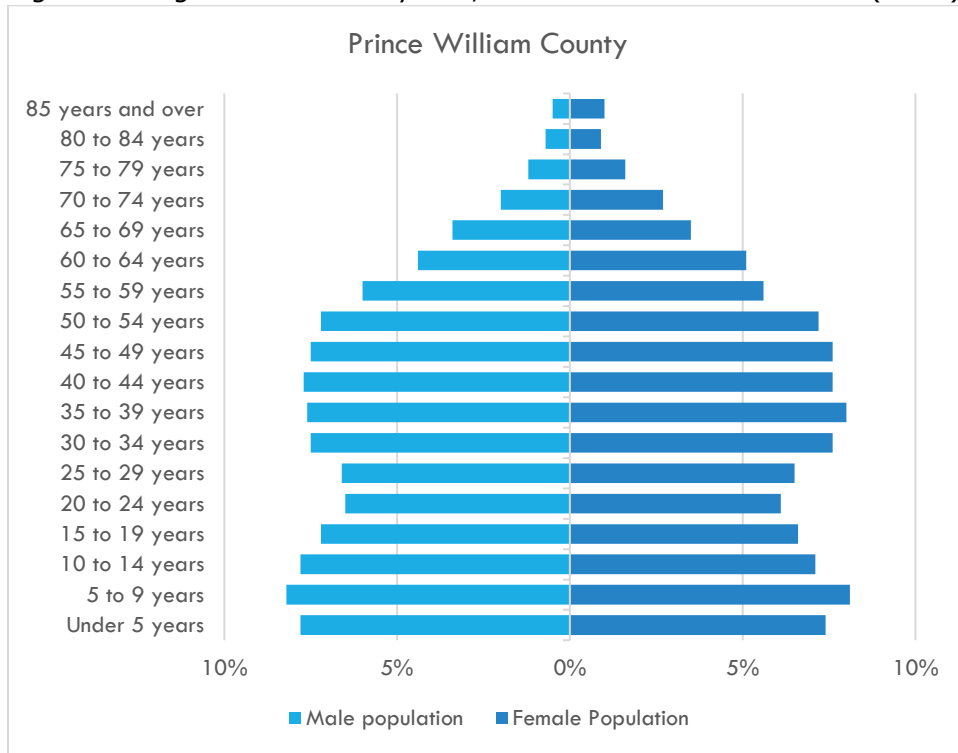
Figure B2. Share of Total Population



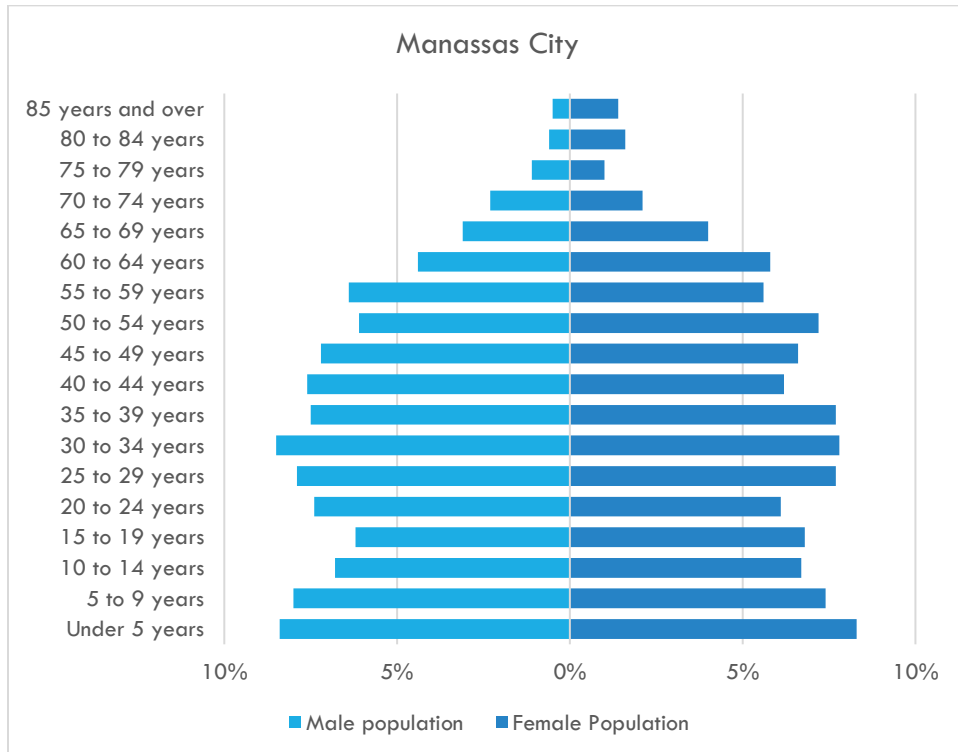

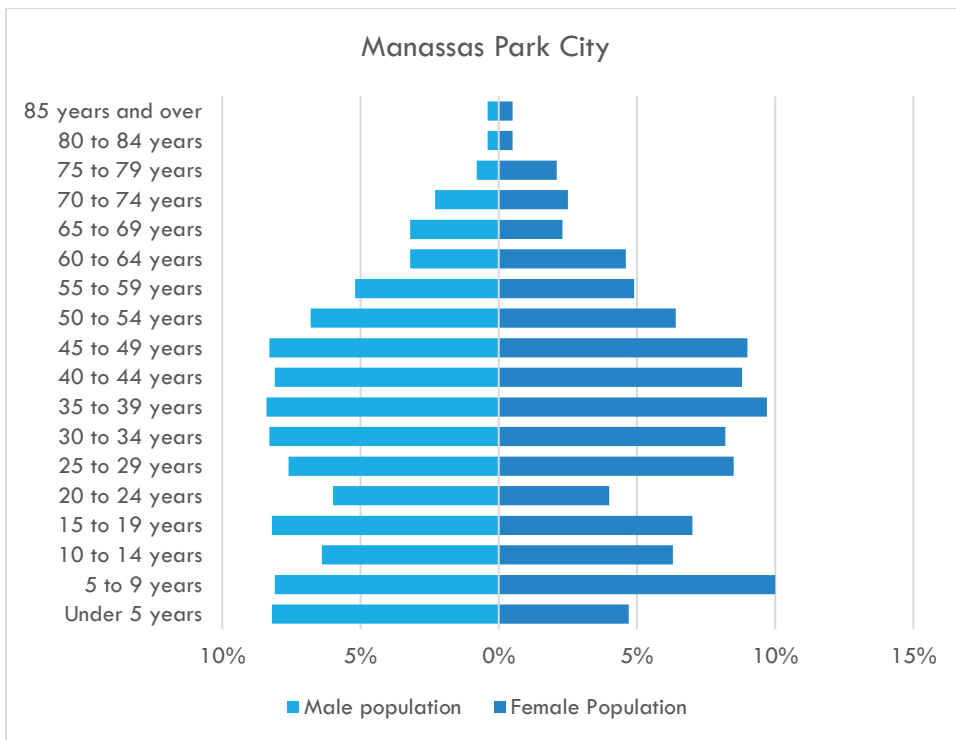
Figure B3. Age Distribution by Sex, Greater Prince William Area (2017)

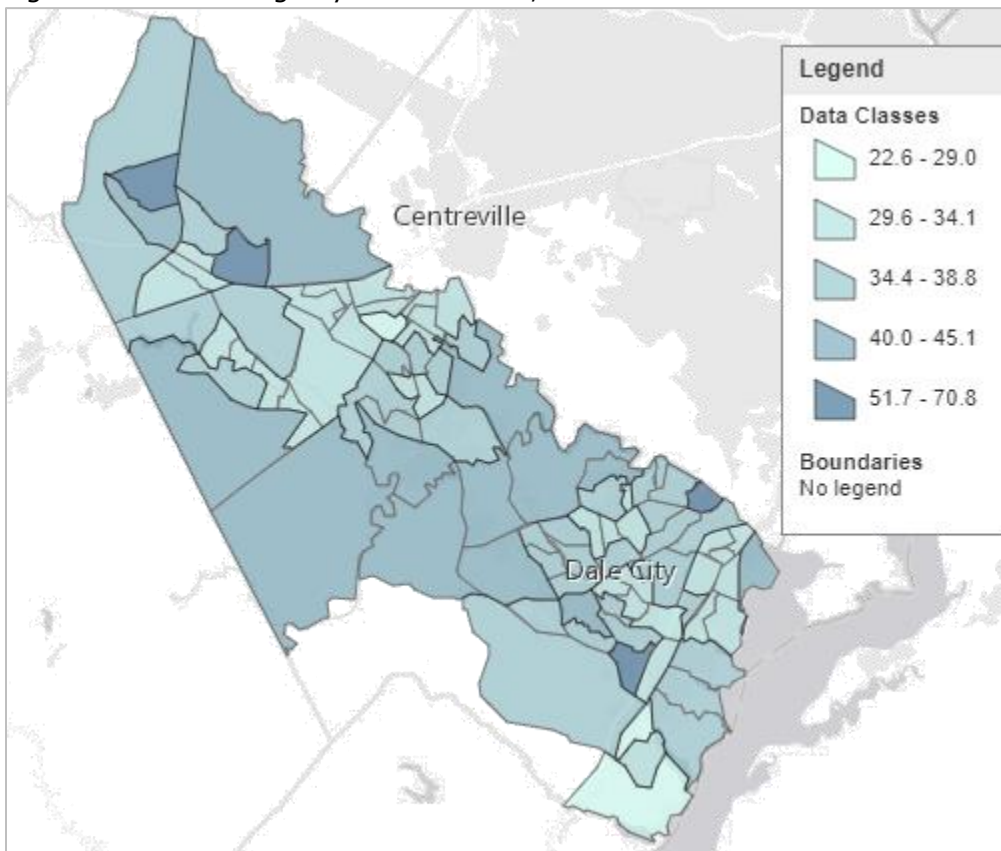

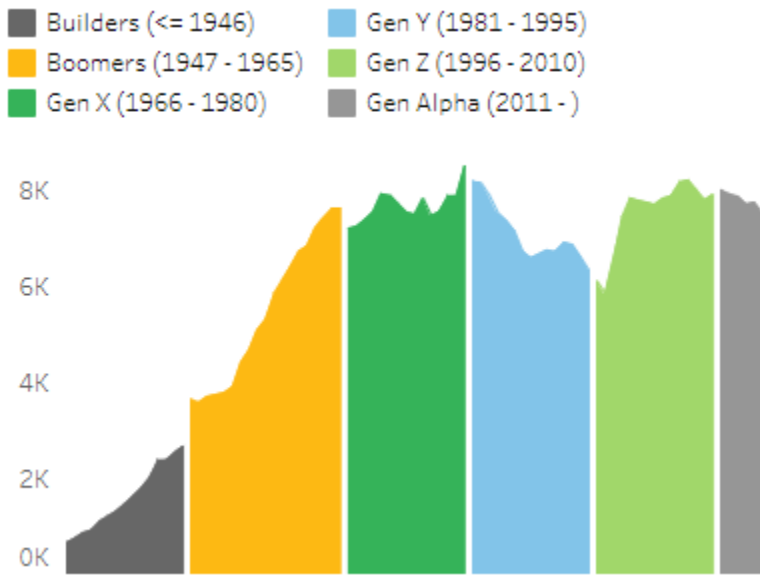

Figure B4. Median Age by Census Tract, Greater Prince William Area



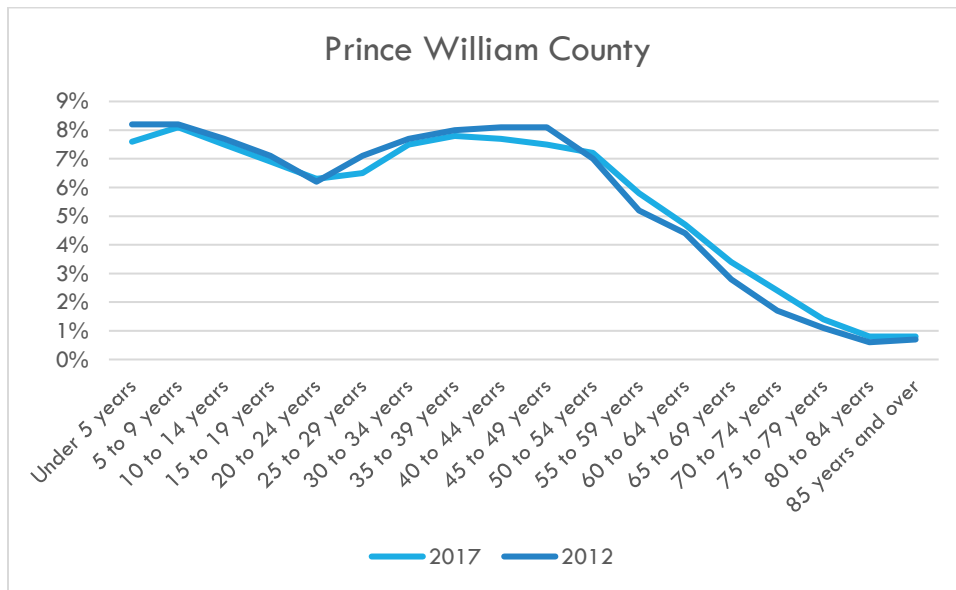

Figure B5. Population by Generation

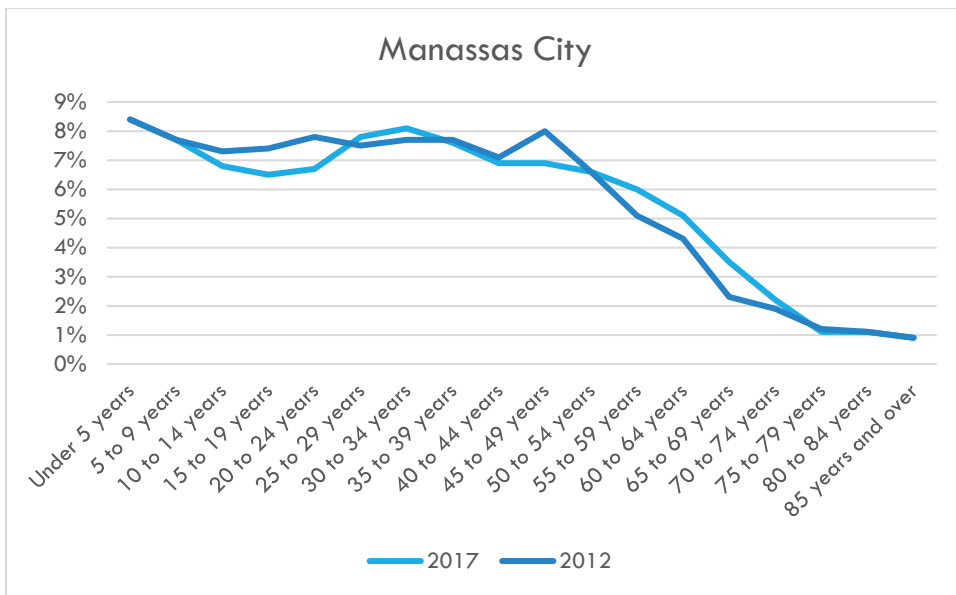

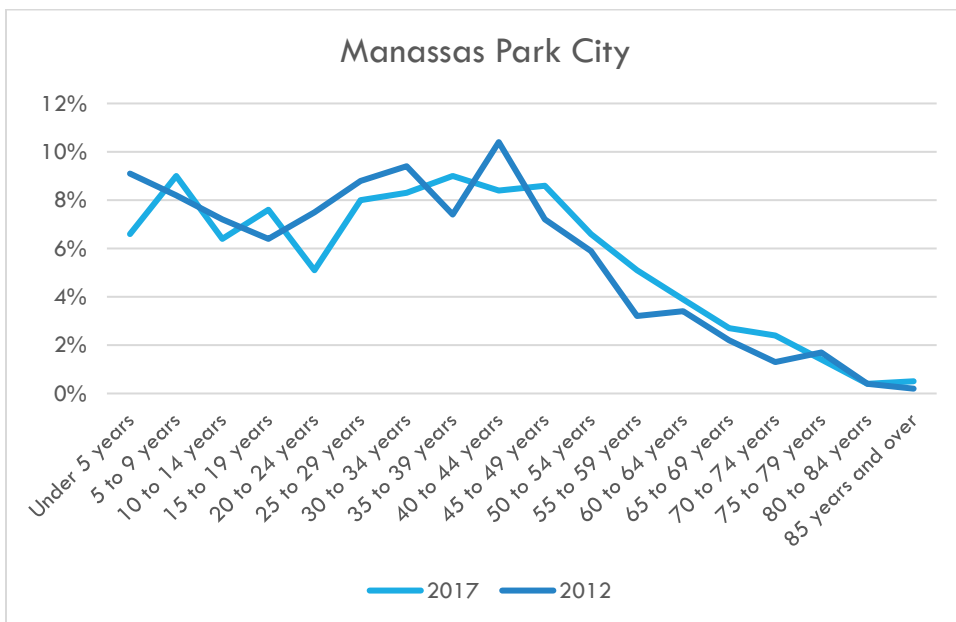
Figure B6. Age Distribution by Year, Greater Prince William Area

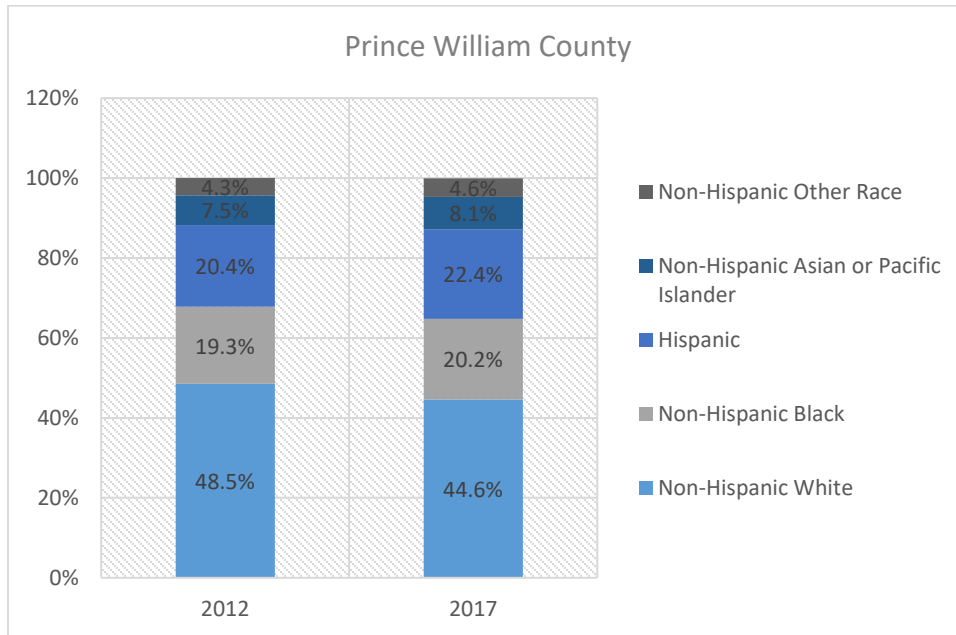

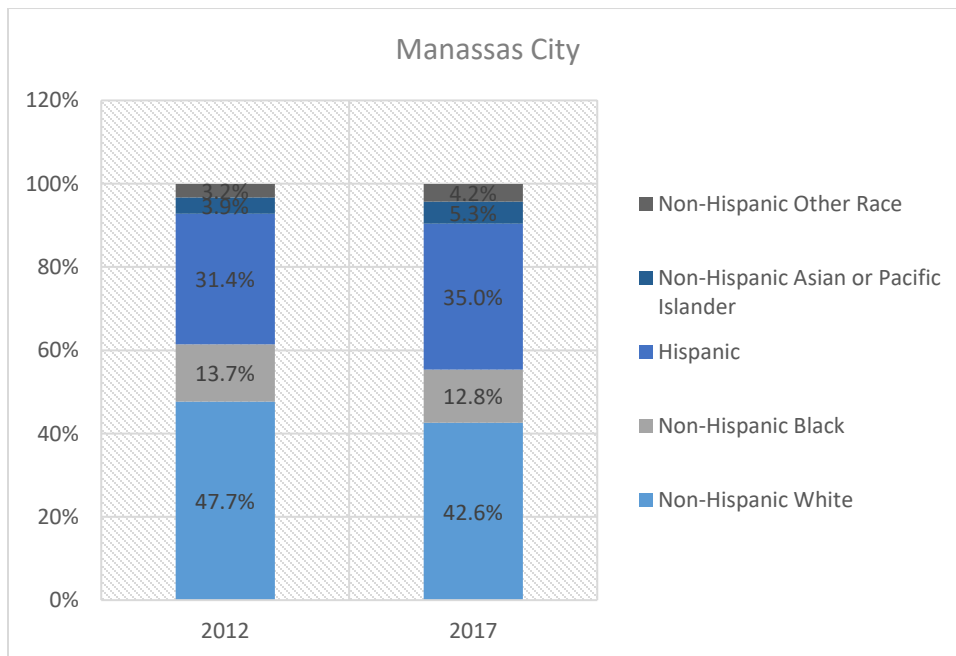

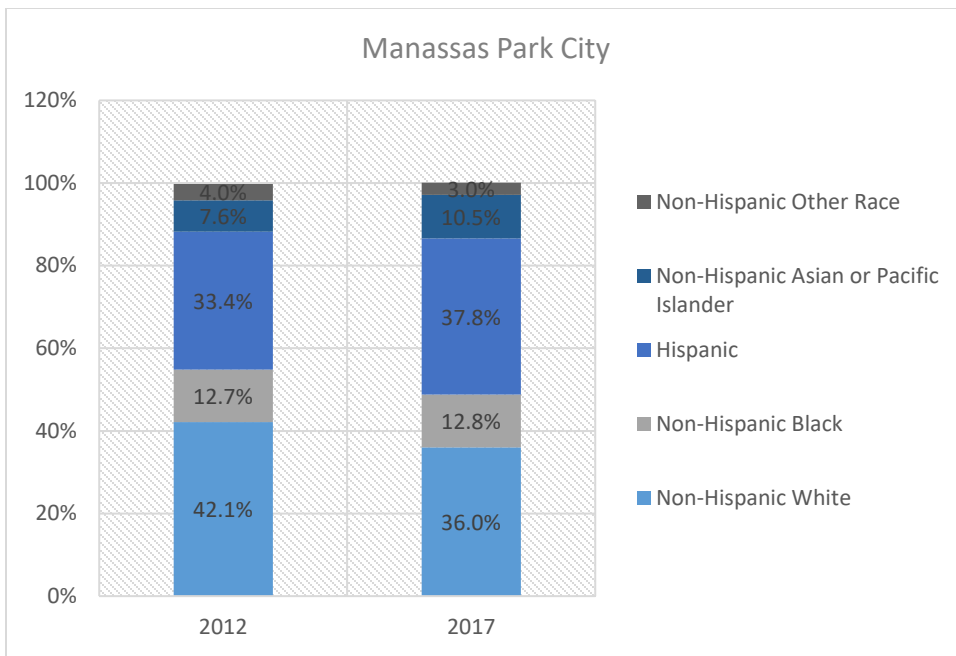
Figure B7. Race and Ethnicity by Year, Greater Prince William Area

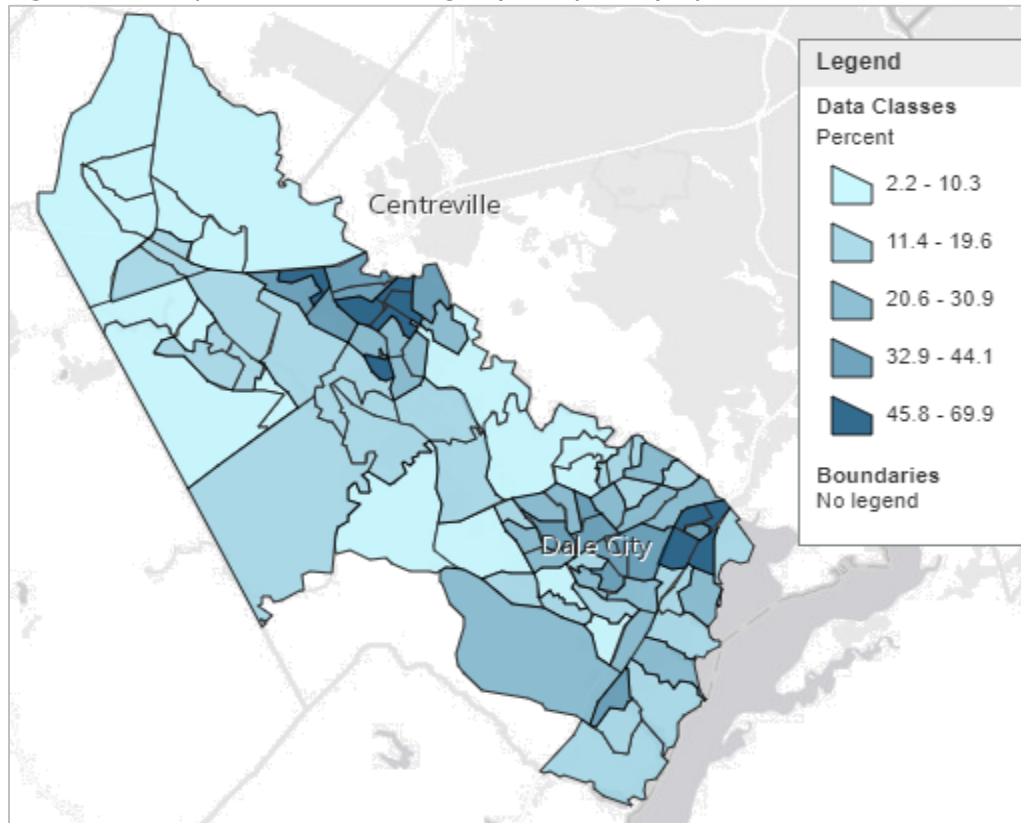

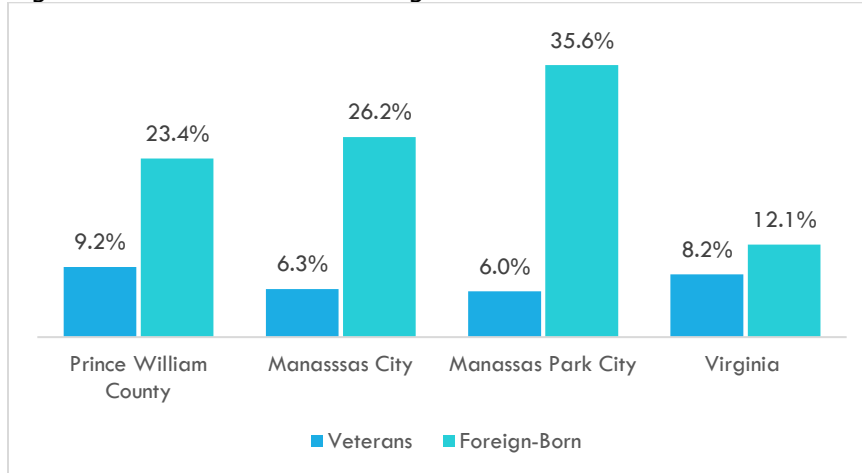
Figure B8. Hispanic or Latino Origin (of any race) by Census Tract

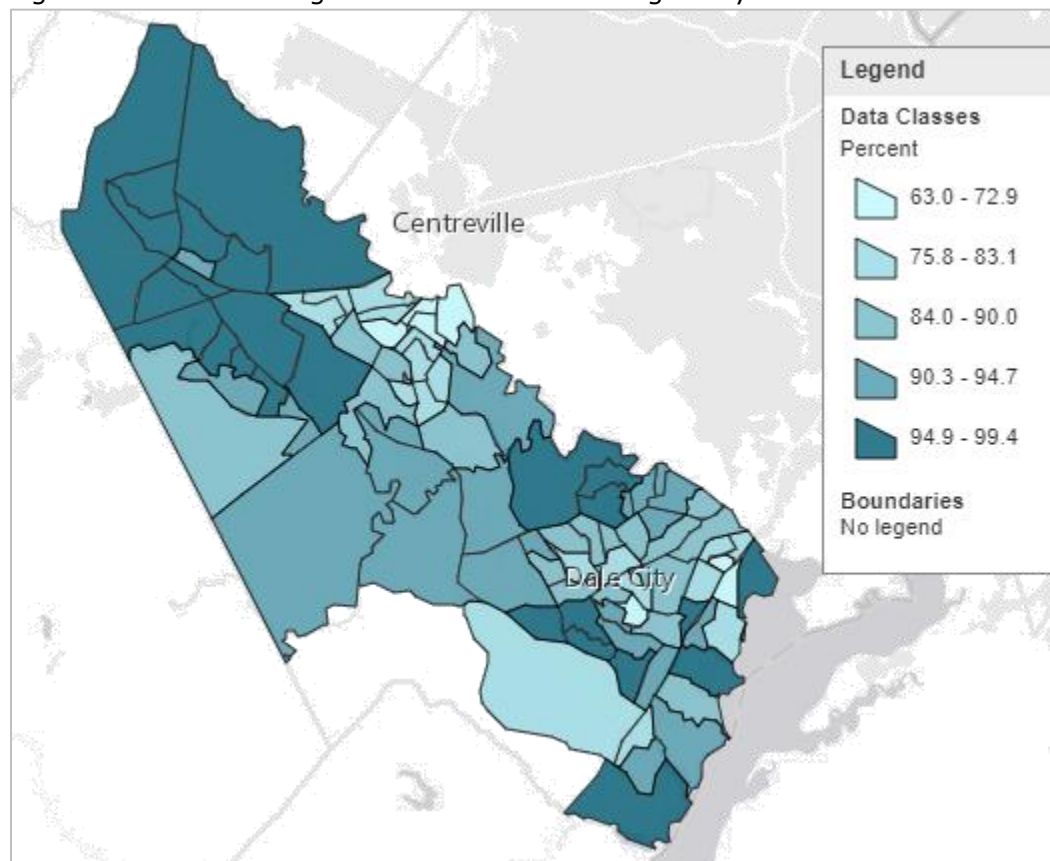

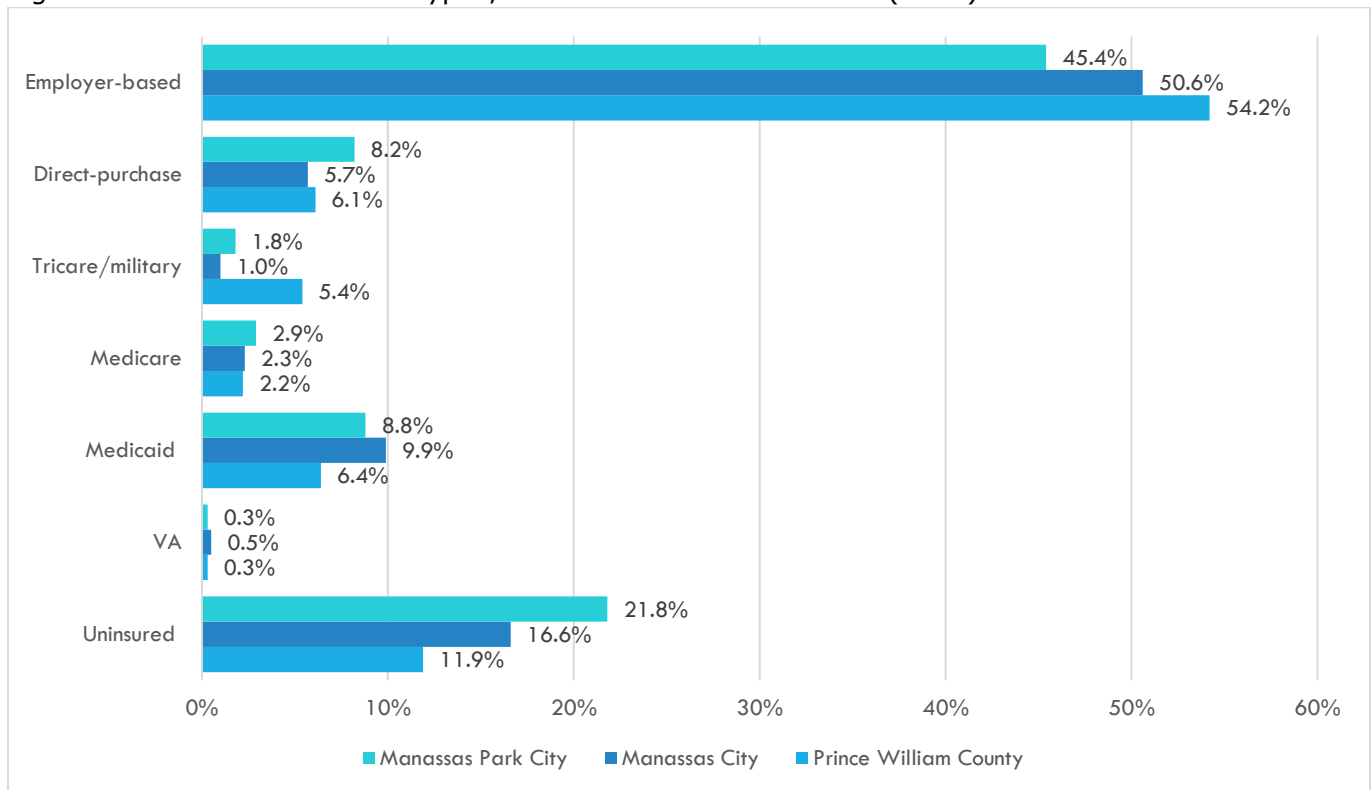
Figure B12. Percent High School Graduate or Higher by Census Tract

Figure B14. Share of Residents Living with a Disability by Disability Type, Greater Prince William Area (2017)

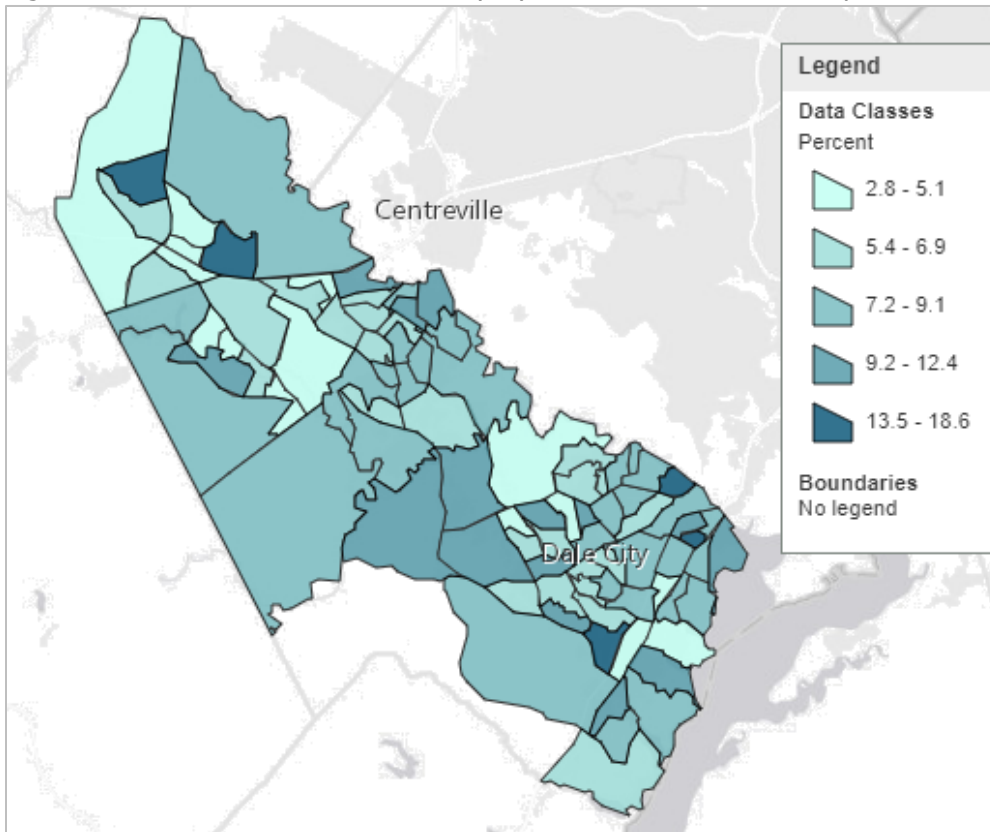

Figure B15. Percent with a Disability by Census Tract, Total Population

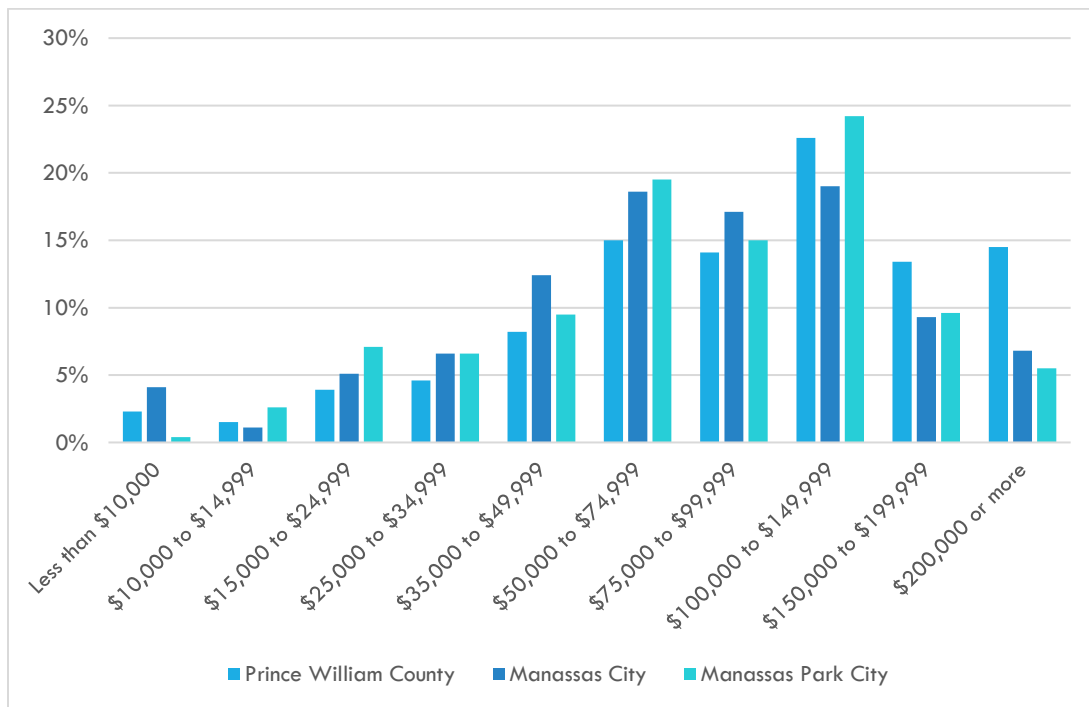

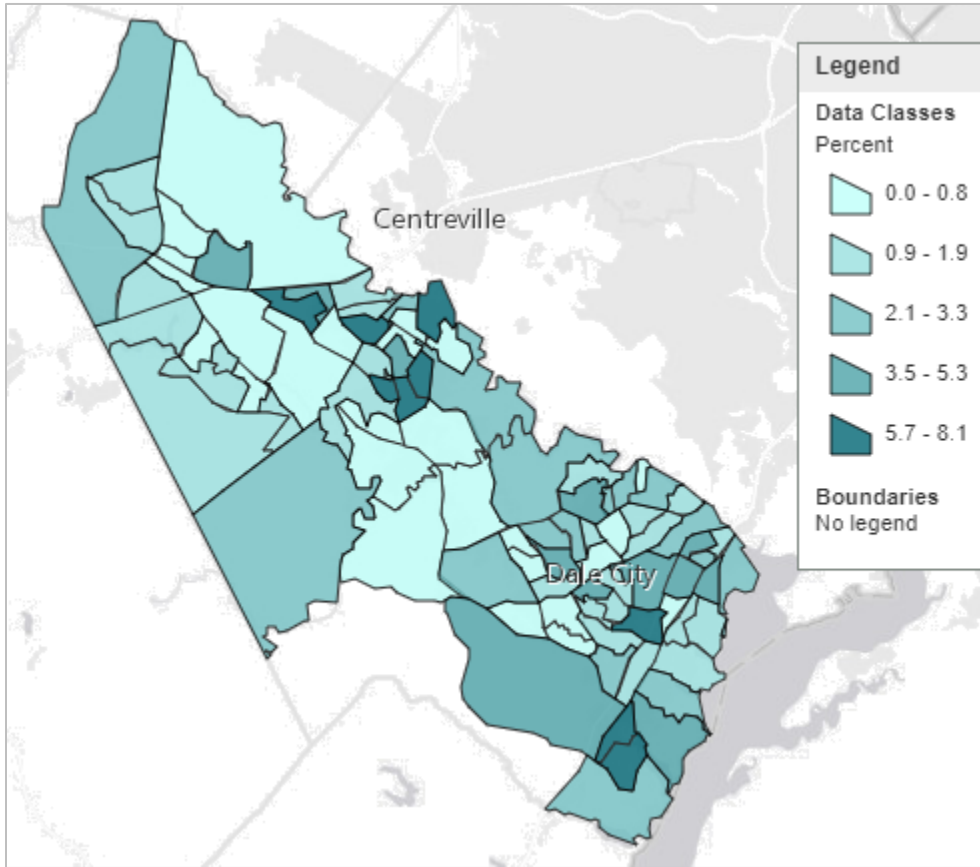

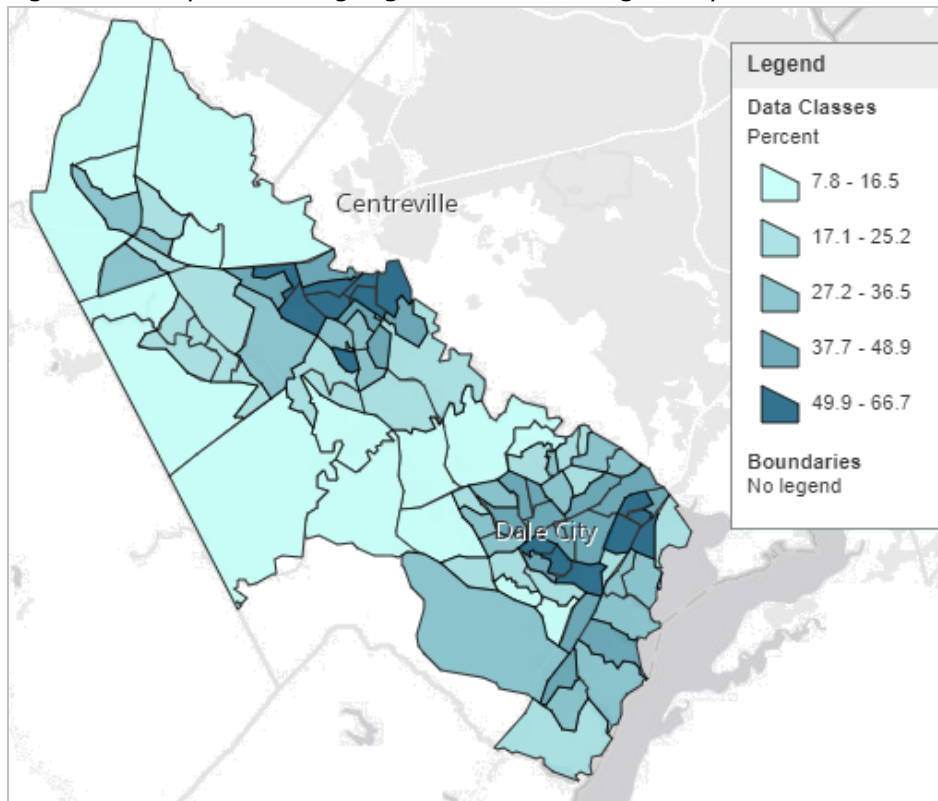

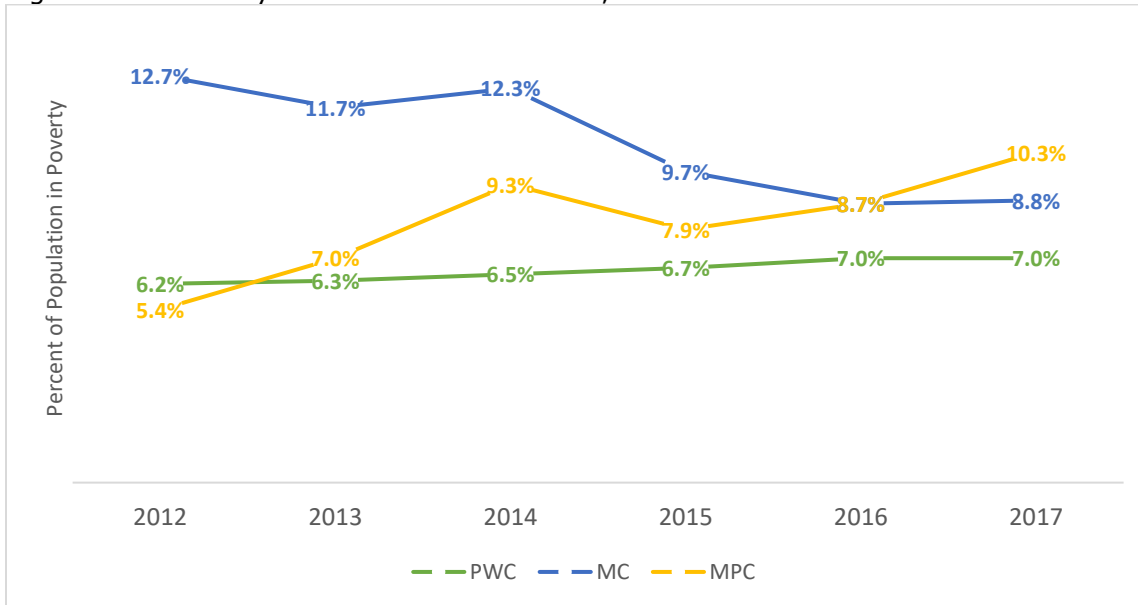

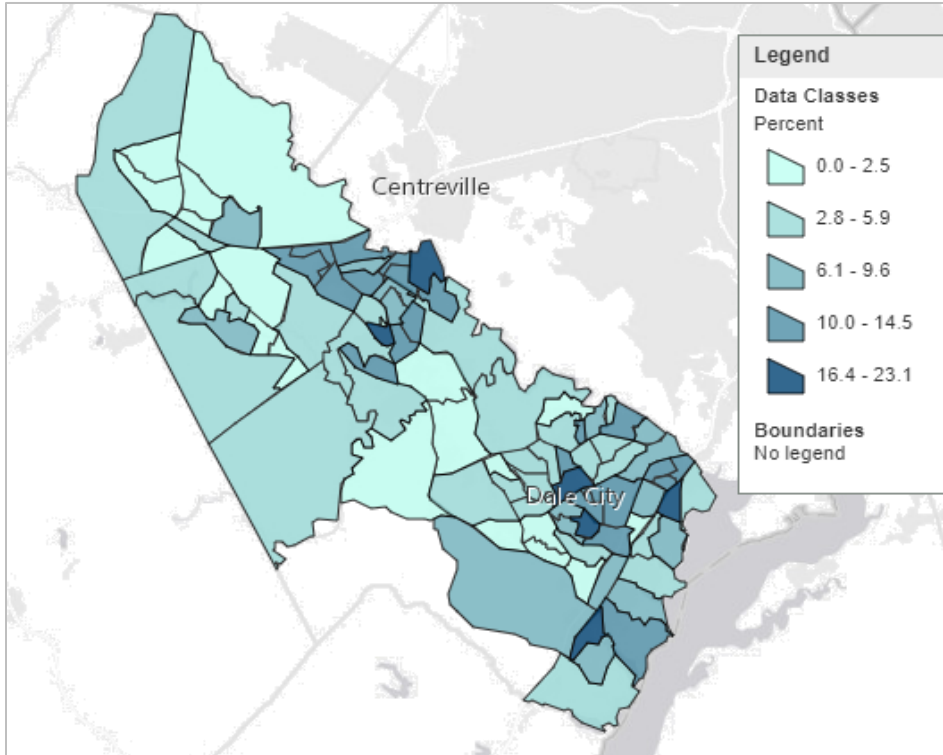

Figure B22. Poverty Trends from 2012-2017, Greater Prince William Area



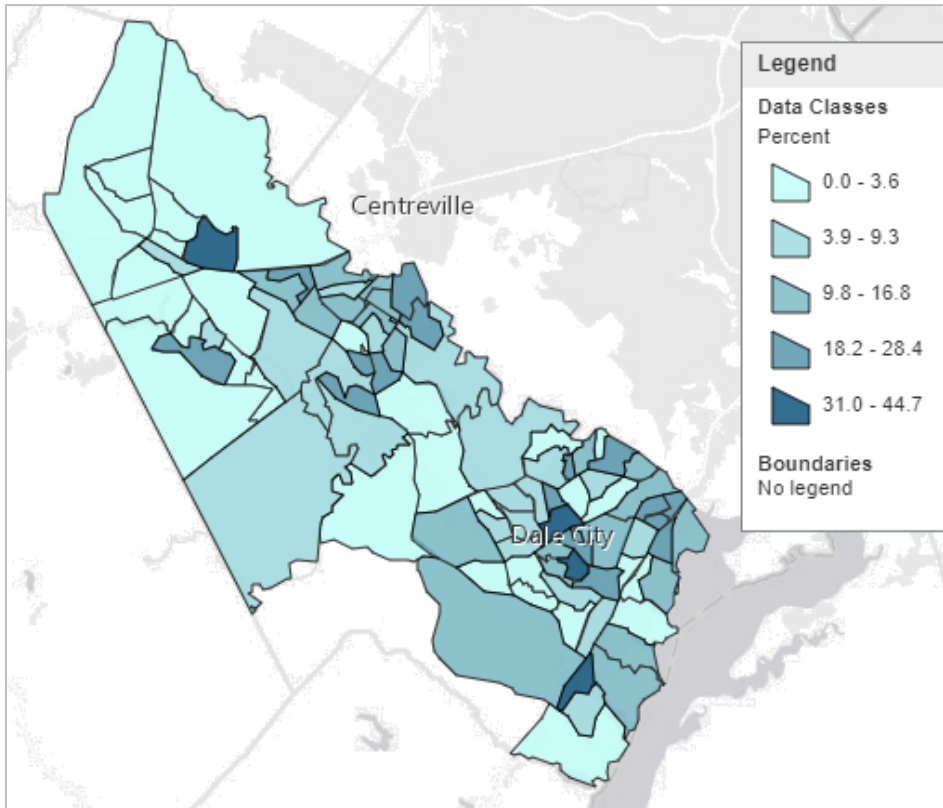

Figure B23. Percent Below Poverty Level by Census Tract, Total Population



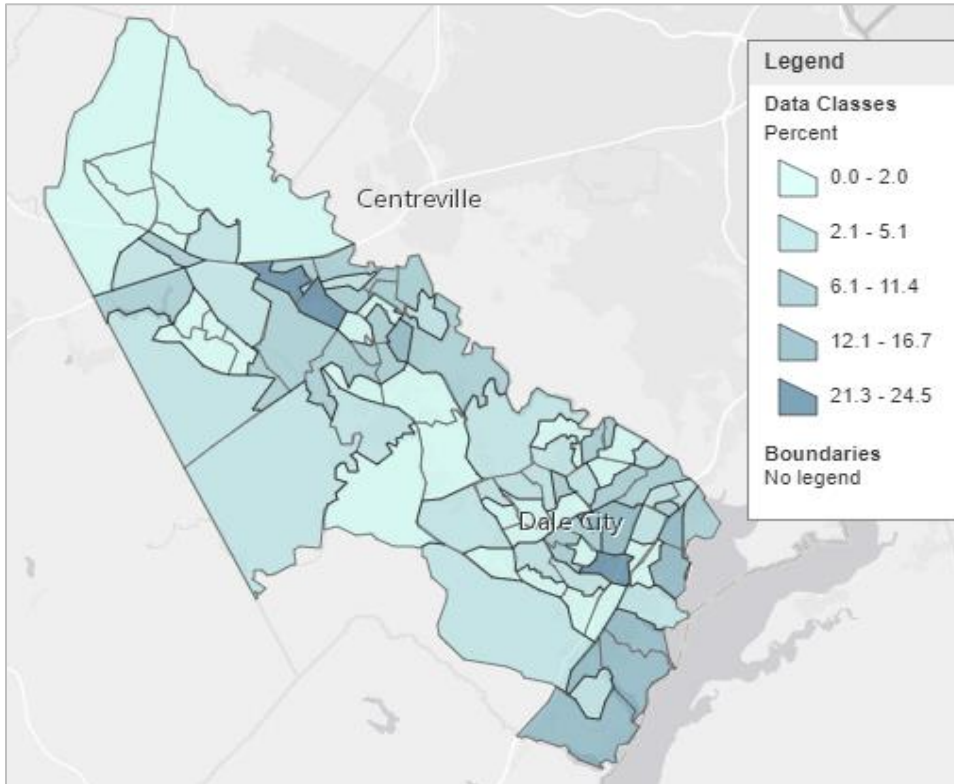

Figure B27. Crime Rate, Greater Prince William Area

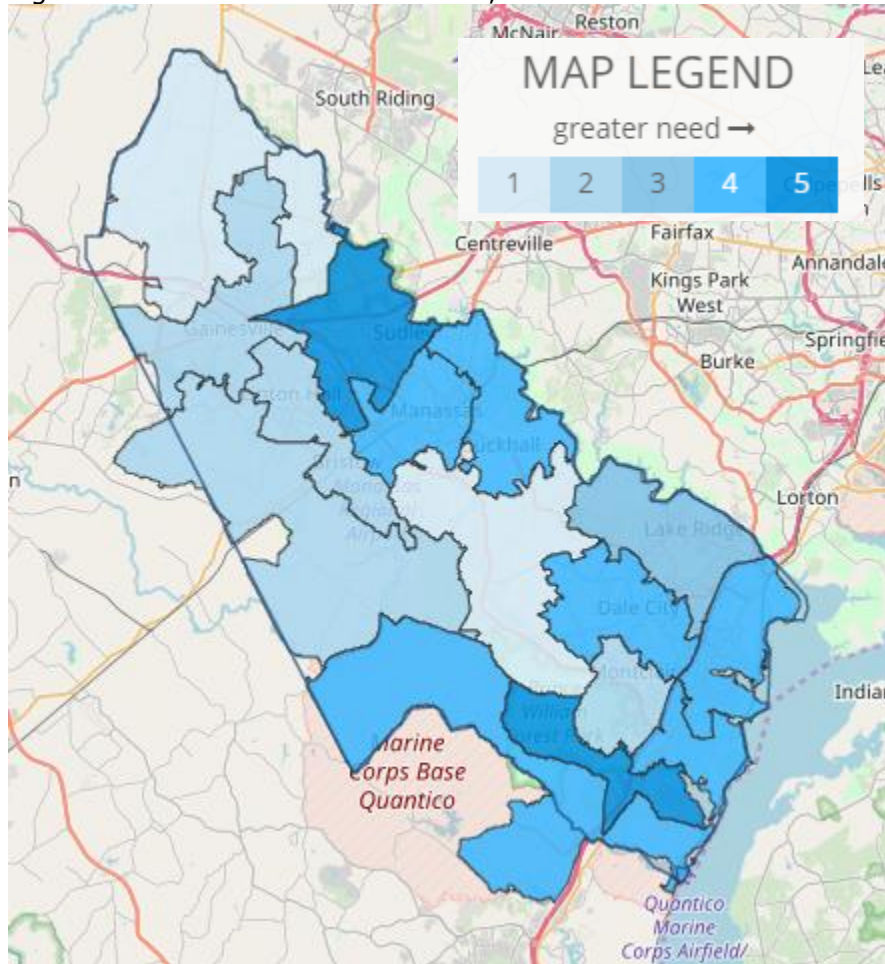

The 2019 SocioNeeds Index, created by [Conduent Healthy Communities Institute](http://www.conduent.com), is a measure of socioeconomic need that is correlated with poor health outcomes. All zip codes, counties, and county equivalents in the United States are given an Index Value from 0 (low need) to 100 (high need). To help you find the areas of highest need in your community, the selected locations are ranked from 1 (low need) to 5 (high need) based on their Index Value.

Figure B28. 2019 SocioNeeds Index, Greater Prince William Area

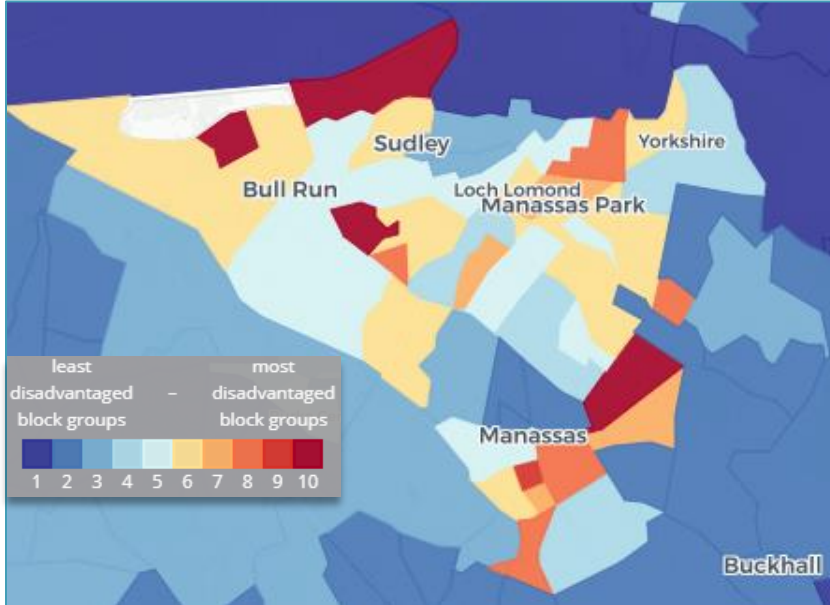
