



Figure B2. Share of Total Population







Figure B3. Age Distribution by Sex, Greater Prince William Area (2017)




Figure B5. Population by Generation





Figure B6. Age Distribution by Year, Greater Prince William Area










Figure B7. Race and Ethnicity by Year, Greater Prince William Area









Figure B13. Health Insurance Types, Greater Prince William Area (2017)








Figure B16. Household Income Distribution, Greater Prince William Area (2017)



Figure B20. Speak a Language Other Than English by Census Tract








Figure B24. Percent Below Poverty Level by Census Tract, Under 18 Years Old




Figure B25. Percent Below Poverty Level by Census Tract, 65 Years and Older


Figure B27. Crime Rate, Greater Prince William Area





Figure B29. Neighborhood Atlas Area Deprivation Index, Greater Prince William Area
