Community-Based Organization

The project proposal identifies 1) specific jurisdiction(s) within the PWHD service area (Prince William County, Cities of Manassas, and Manassas Park), 2) Demonstrates broad reach into populations identified as those disproportionately affected by COVID-19, and 3) Describes experience in collaboration with other community partners, entities, and organizations to help improve health outcomes.

Weighted at 25% - If your organization is not currently active in Prince William County, Manassas, or Manassas Park, your application will not be considered.

Project Management/Goals

The project proposal meets overall goals established by Cycle 4 funding. 1) Target populations are clearly identified, 2) Project activities clearly address populations experiencing heaviest burden of illness and/or lowest vaccination rates, 3) Project activities ensure greater equity and access to COVID-19 vaccines, and 4) Project proposal conveys intent to continue vaccination efforts with ongoing activities after the grant period ends.

Weighted at 50%

Budget/Funding

The project proposal demonstrates 1) an understanding of and the ability to work within the reimbursement model, 2) establishes that the use of funding will implement, support, and/or expand vaccination activities, and 3) explains ways in which funded activities will focus on vaccine education, awareness, and uptake in populations at higher risk of COVID-19.

Weighted at 25%

Sustainability

Sustainability is a key component of grant activities so that the Greater Prince William Region is prepared for the potential need for distributing additional booster vaccines and to implement influenza vaccination both seasonally and for pandemic preparedness. These activities should improve access to COVID-19 vaccine, as well as necessary vaccines, for at-risk individuals. Please describe these efforts in your narrative.
