Did You Know?

The <u>County Health Rankings and Roadmaps</u> (CHR&R) is a collaboration between the <u>Robert Wood Johnson Foundation</u> and the <u>University of Wisconsin Population Health Institute</u>.

Over the last decade, CHR&R ranked the health of counties within states, providing a way to understand differences in health. This year CHR&R has replaced that method and introduced a <u>new sharper data-driven approach</u> that allows comparisons of a county's health with other counties, whether that's in the same state or across the nation.


Within each County Health Snapshot there are **two new visuals for health outcomes and health factors.** The county-level measures are compiled from a variety of national and state data sources. All data is standardized and combined using scientifically informed weights.

Why Does This Matter?

Comparisons among counties provide context and show that where you live, work, grow, and play can deeply affect your ability to live a healthy life.

The CHR&R's model of health's measures aims to spark conversations and action to address the health challenges and gaps highlighted in these findings.

You can help make a sustainable change by learning, sharing, and advocating for investment in creating a healthier and happier community.













