Did You Know?

The <u>County Health Rankings and Roadmaps</u> (CHR&R) is a collaboration between the <u>Robert Wood</u> <u>Johnson Foundation</u> and the <u>University of Wisconsin Population Health Institute</u>.

Over the last decade, CHR&R ranked the health of counties within states, providing a way to understand differences in health. This year CHR&R has replaced that method and introduced a <u>new sharper data-</u> <u>driven approach</u> that allows comparisons of a county's health with other counties, whether that's in the same state or across the nation.

Within each County Health Snapshot there are **two new visuals for health outcomes and health factors.** The county-level measures are compiled from a variety of national and state data sources. All data is standardized and combined using scientifically informed weights.

Why Does This Matter?


Health outcomes tell us how long people live on average within a community, and how much physical and mental health people experience in a community while they are alive.


