From Cycle 4 Grantee to CHA Co-Creator

Before the CHA

- **Feb. 2024:** Awarded Cycle 4 grant
- Health literacy initiative

During the CHA

- Reviewed facilitator guide, simplified language, helped make materials accessible
- Introduced us to community members who are English language learners (ELL) , distributed health surveys, and hosted 3 community conversations

After the CHA

- **Oct. 1, 2025:** Shared back findings, integrated CHA into lesson



Sharing CHA Results Back: Vocabulary Review

Key Vocabulary

Community

A group of people who live in the same place or share something important like culture or work.



Survey

Questions asked to many people on paper or online.



Health Information

Facts or knowledge about ways to be healthy.



Assessment

A way to look at something carefully to understand it or measure it.



Data

Information often shown as numbers that we collect to learn something.



Bar Chart - A picture that uses bars (lines) to show and compare numbers



Pie Chart - A circle divided into pieces that show parts of a whole.

Sharing CHA Results: Mental Health Focus

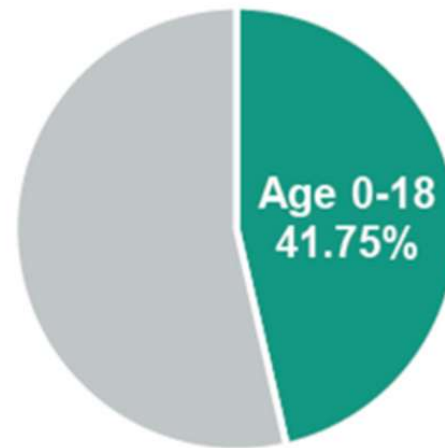
In 2024, minors (children and teens) and adults went to the emergency room for mental health and behavior problems.



2024 SNVMC Emergency Department Behavioral Health Visits

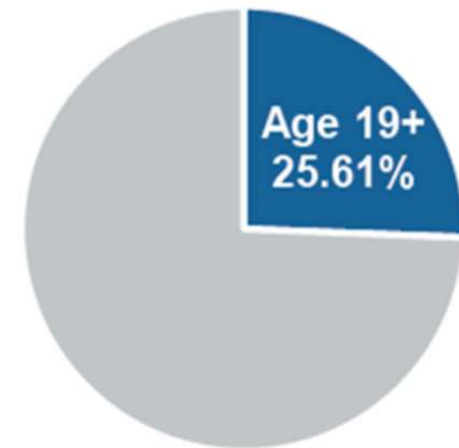


Minors




Minors had a higher rate of visits for suicidal thoughts than adults.

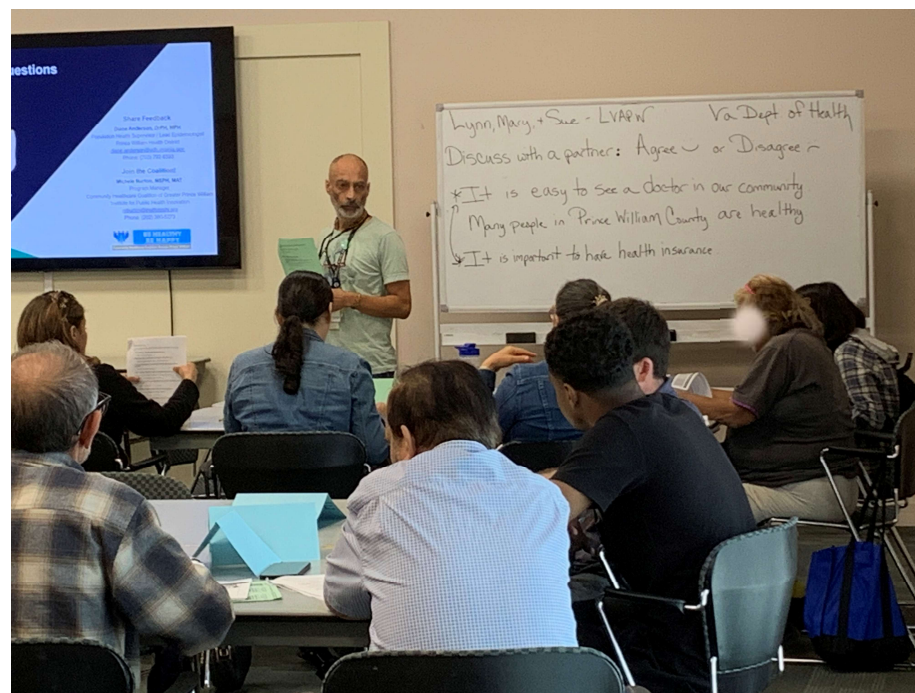
