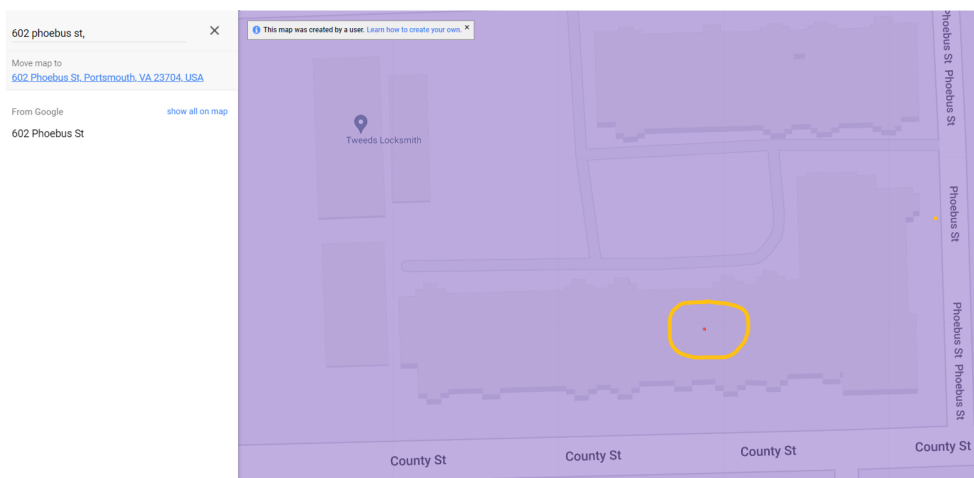


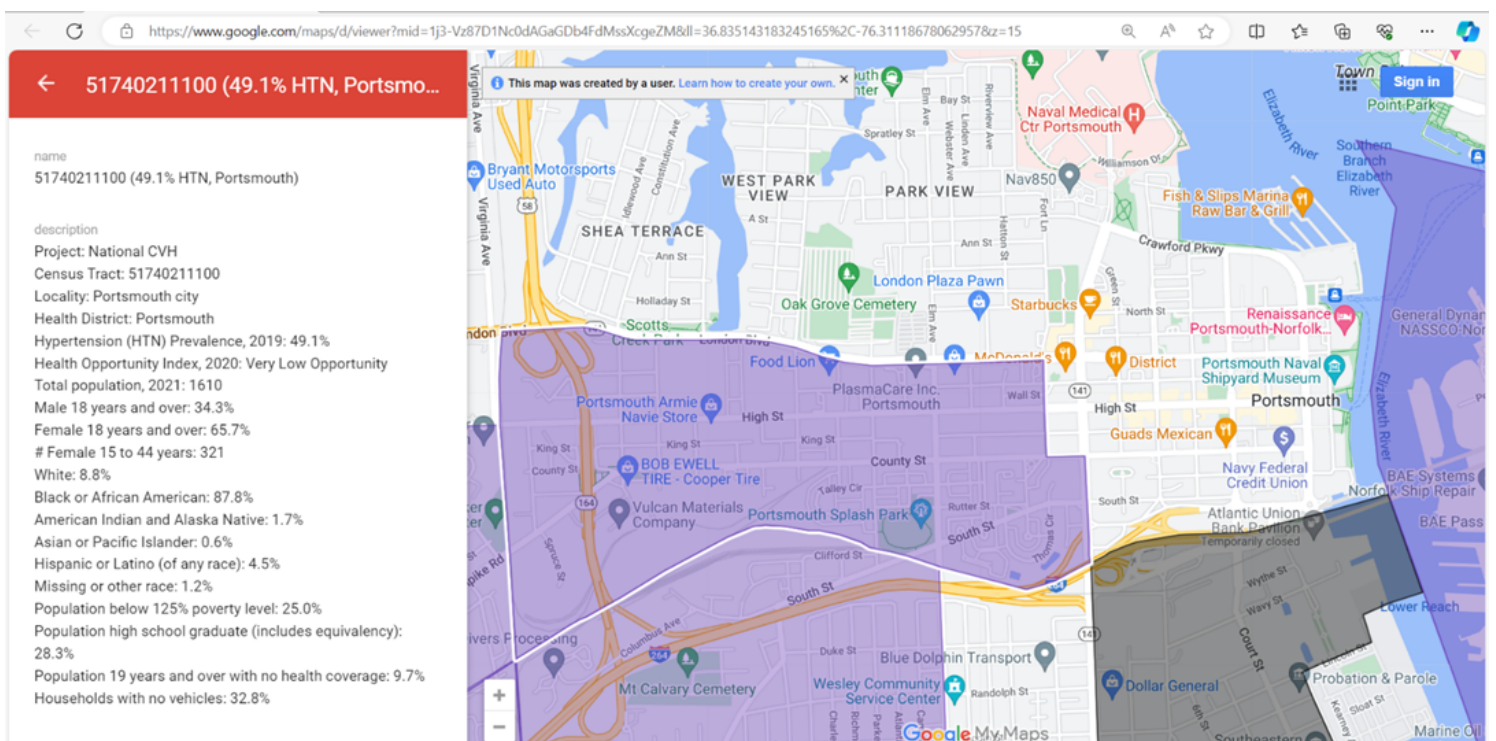
How to Find an Address Within the National and Innovative Cardiovascular Health Program Census Tracts

To search for an address and determine if it is located within a census tract for the Cardiovascular Health (CVH) programs, please follow the steps outlined below:

1. Navigate to the Google Map for the CVH census tracts: <https://www.vdh.virginia.gov/heart-disease/virginia-cardiovascular-health-program/>
2. Expand the map to full screen by clicking on VIEW LARGER MAP icon in top right corner.
3. Click on the SEARCH icon on the top left-hand side of the map.
4. Enter the full street address into the search bar.
5. The address will appear as a small red dot as highlighted in the map below.



6. Zoom out on the map and click anywhere inside the highlighted census tract except for the small dot. This will select corresponding census tract where the address is located.
