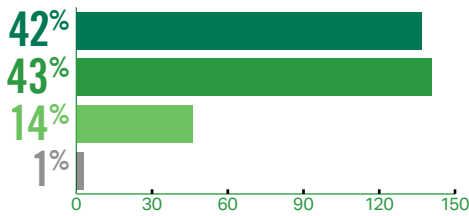


Behavioral Health Facilities Survey

GENERAL DEMOGRAPHICS

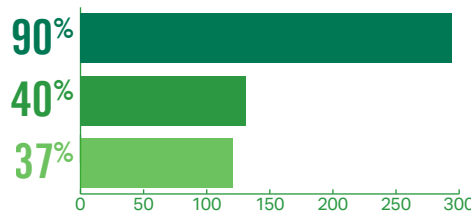
- Administered from August to September 2020 to assess tobacco use and cessation practices and policies in behavioral health facilities in Virginia
- 327 behavioral health facilities participated
- Participating facilities were located in 81 (out of 133) localities in Virginia

FACILITY SETTING



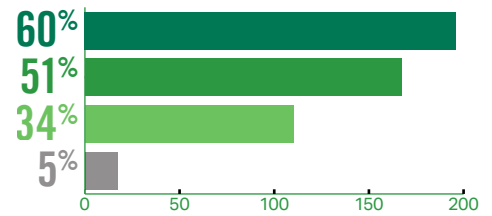
- 42% (137) indicated they were residential facilities
- 43% (141) indicated they were outpatient facilities
- 14% (46) indicated they were both
- 1% (3) did not respond

PATIENT FOCUS



- 90% (294) serve adults
- 40% (131) serve adolescents
- 37% (121) serve children

AREAS OF LICENSURE



- Mental Health 60% (196)
- Developmental Disabilities 51% (167)
- Substance Abuse 34% (110)
- Other 5% (17)

TOBACCO POLICY

- 60%** (197) facilities prohibit all tobacco products indoors
- 20%** (65) facilities prohibit all tobacco products indoors and outdoors
- 10%** (34) facilities do not prohibit tobacco use
- 10%** Other



SCREENING FOR TOBACCO USE

Only **44%** (144) of facilities screen patients for tobacco use
