The Tobacco Control Program (TCP) and Quit Now Virginia is working to advance the use of evidence-based standard-of-care tobacco treatment in a variety of areas across Virginia to include partner sites, faith-based organizations, pharmacies, and behavioral health facilities. The [Duke-UNC Tobacco Treatment Specialist Training Program](#) offers evidence-based medical and behavioral tobacco treatment trainings in a comprehensive training package as well as in one-day intensive trainings for healthcare and public health professionals. All courses are online and interactive for the best learning experience.

Starting in Spring 2023, the Tobacco Control Program is offering healthcare, public health professionals and other interested entities who may qualify for scholarships the opportunity to attend these training programs. This scholarship opportunity is for individuals that specifically serve marginalized areas of Virginia and do not have the funds within their organization to cover the cost of the training.

To ensure this training is available to as many individuals as possible, scholarships are available for two (2) individuals per facility/program. This scholarship will cover one (1) training course per person. Availability is first come, first served.
