Grant Funding

Community water fluoridation is one of the top ten public health achievements of the 20th century – it has led to a dramatic decline in tooth decay.

Virginia Department of Health, Dental Health Program provides grant funding for equipment and supplies used for community water fluoridation.



Grant Application Requirements:

- Letter of Request on official letterhead that includes:
 - Signature of Town Manager or Utilities Director
 - Brief description of community and type of water system
 - Number of people served
 - Description of proposed project
 - Itemized estimate of costs of fluoridation project: equipment, shipping, planning, engineering, installation and minor remodeling
- Grants are awarded via contract
- VDH must receive paid invoices by the designated deadline within the contract
- Invoices will be reimbursed upon proof of payment

Eligible items:

- Equipment
- Shipping
- Planning
- Engineering
- Installation
- Minor remodeling

Ineligible items:

- Construction
- Projects not associated with fluoridation
