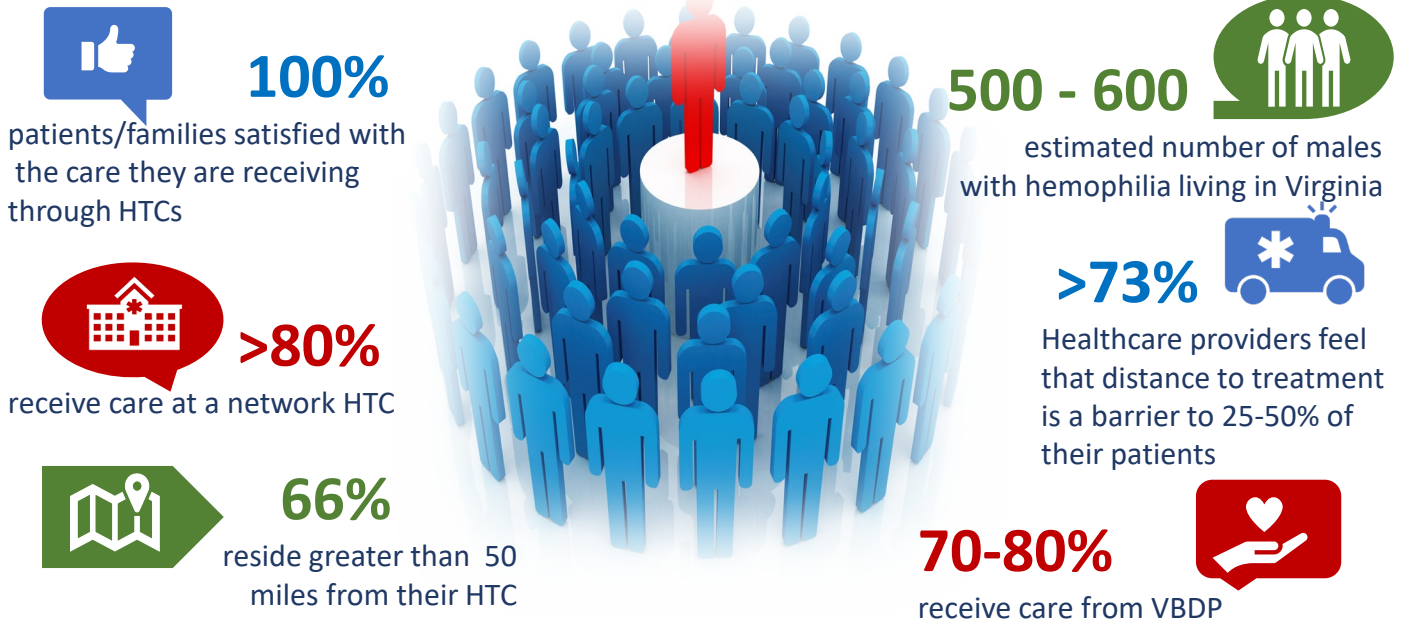

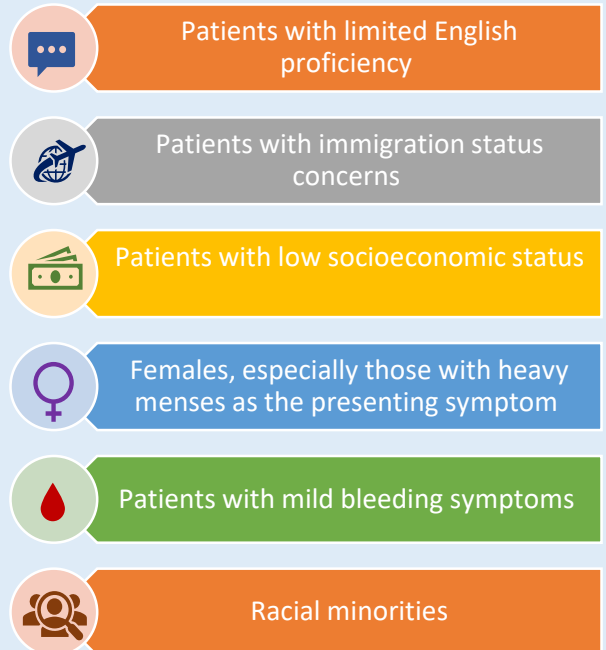


Top needs identified

Based on the key findings from the Needs Assessment Project, the VBDP is creating committees and special projects to:

Expand

- Expand access to VBDP for patients with inherited bleeding disorders other than factor deficiencies

Support

- Support strategies to reduce distance as a barrier to care

Reduce

- Reduce insurance barriers

Increase

- Increase awareness regarding services for mental health, pain management, dental care, nutrition, substance abuse, genetics counseling
