Did you know


In the U.S. 11.5% of drivers do not buckle up.
In Virginia, nearly 20% of drivers do not wear seat belts.



732 Virginians died in
motor vehicle
accidents in 2015



Death rates are **8**
times higher when the
passenger is not buckled




Why is this important?

Seat belts saved **12,802** lives in 2014



Seat belts reduce the risk of fatal
injuries to a front seat passenger by **45%**

Put children ages
7 or younger
in safety seats



Buckle up before you
drive off
