


# Hypertension Central Shenandoah and Lord Fairfax HDs








## Hypertension Rappahannock/Rapidan and Rappahannock HDs








## Hypertension Thomas Jefferson and Piedmont HDs



% incidence rate








# Hypertension Alleghany, Roanoke and Central Virginia HDs

















## Hypertension Pittsylvania/Danville, Southside and West Piedmont HDs


















# Hypertension Crater, Peninsula and Hampton HDs




% incidence rate





# Hypertension Eastern Shore and Three Rivers HDs



Additional diagnostics
