



Virginia offers several scholarship opportunities to help pay for nursing education in exchange for service in Virginia after graduation. Scholarships are available for students enrolled in an approved nurse education program in Virginia. The program must prepare them for examination for licensure as a: Licensed Practical Nurses, Registered Nurses, Nurse Practitioners (NP), Nurse Midwives (NM), and Nurse Educators (NE) scholarships are for students enrolled at an accredited program in the state of Virginia.

Scholarship Programs

- Mary Marshall Nursing Scholarship Program for Licensed Practical Nurses (LPN)
- Mary Marshall Nursing Scholarship Program for Registered Nurses (RN)
- Virginia's Nurse Practitioner/Nurse Midwife Scholarship Program
- Virginia Nurse Educator Scholarship Program

Funding for the Mary Marshall Nursing Scholarship Program (MMNSP) is dependent upon funds appropriated each year by the Virginia General Assembly and by Board of Nursing, as well as the number of qualified applicants. Participants in the MMNSP shall receive \$2,000 per year for up to four years. Awards for the Virginia's Nurse Practitioner/Nurse Midwife (NP/NM) and the Nurse Educator (NE) Scholarship Program are dependent upon funds appropriated each year by the Virginia General Assembly. Participants in the NP/NM and NE scholarship programs can receive up to \$20,000 per year for up to four years while in school.

Eligibility

All programs require residency in Virginia for at least one year and full or part-time enrollment in the appropriate educational program along with a completed application and other required materials. The applicants must also:

- MMNSP for LPNs and RNs requires a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 and a demonstration of financial need, verifiable by the financial aid office of the applicant's nursing school.
- The NP/NM program requires a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.
