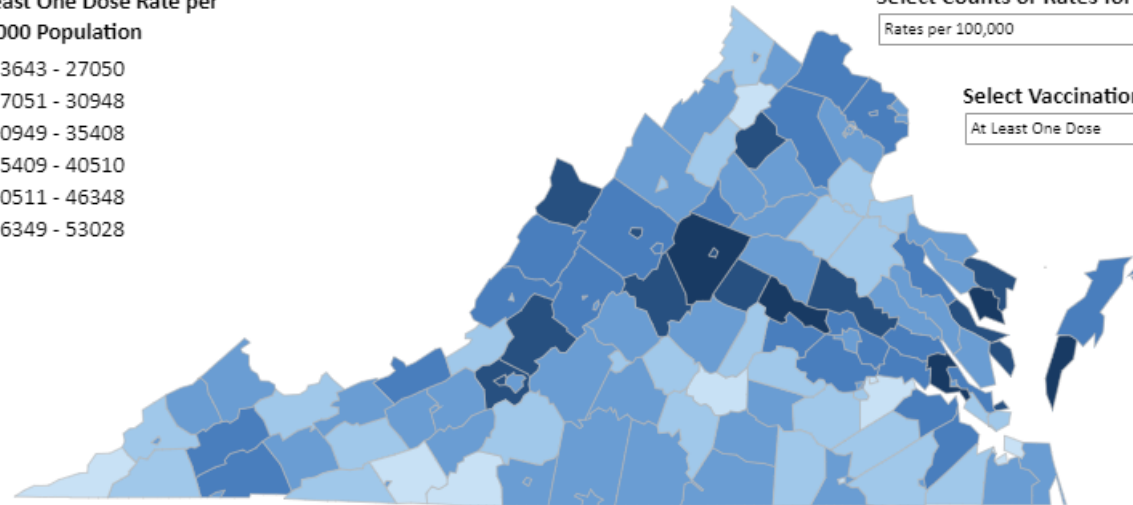

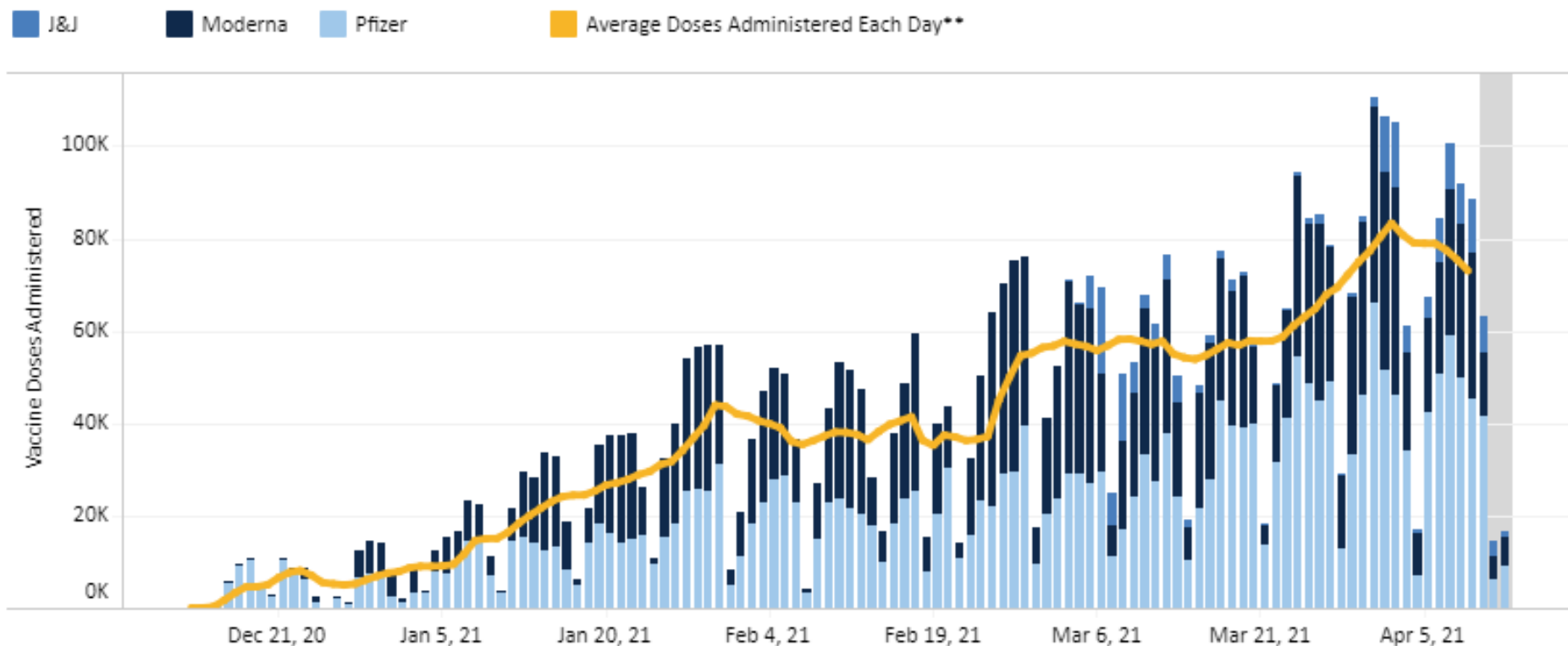

Each Day\*\*

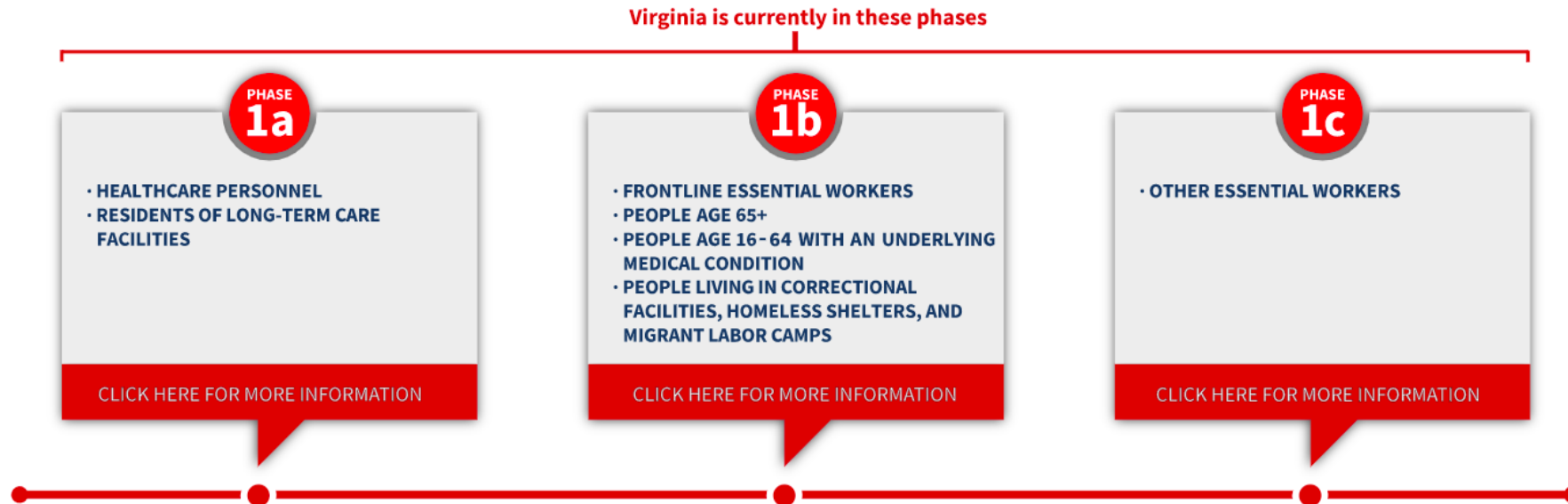
**72,958**

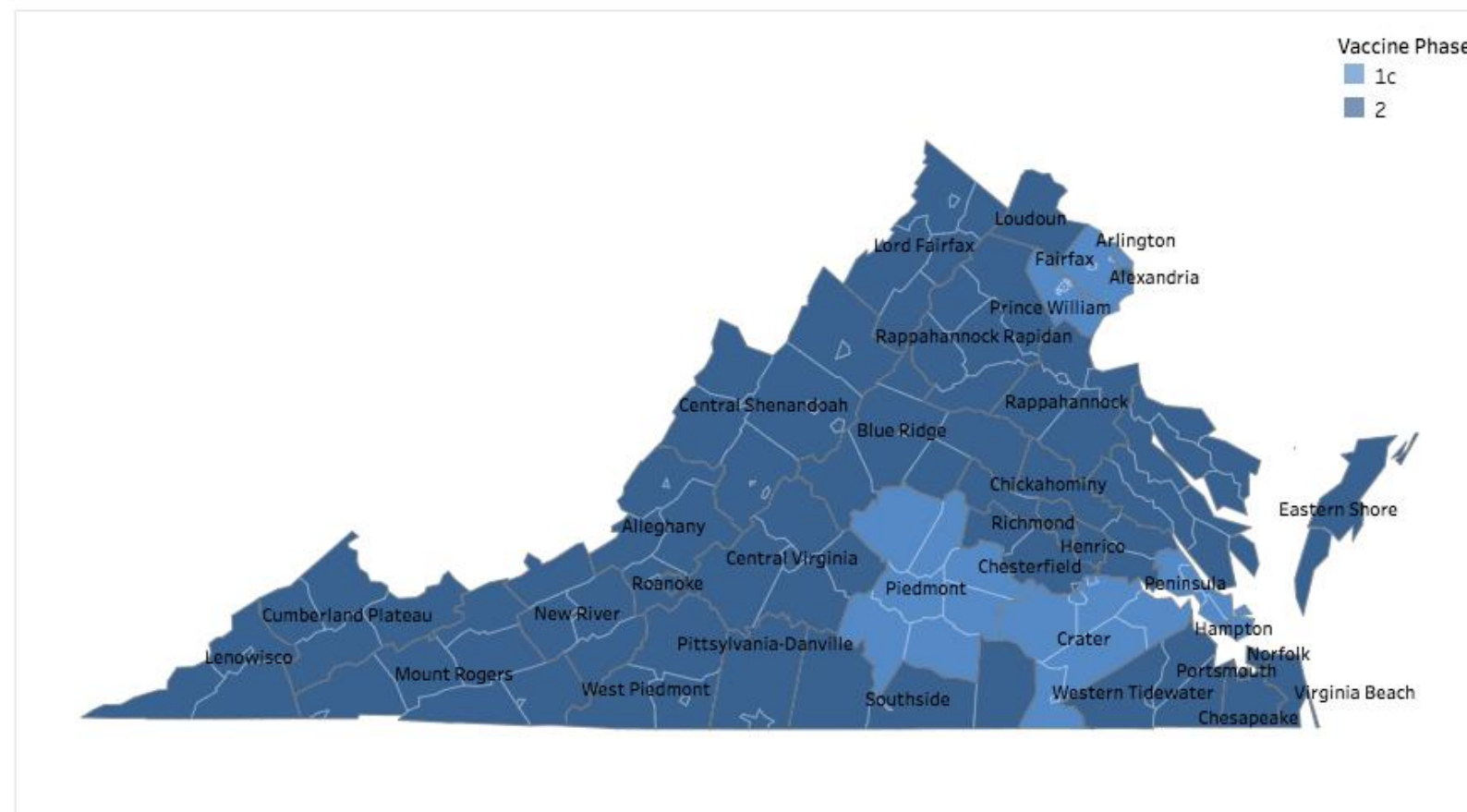

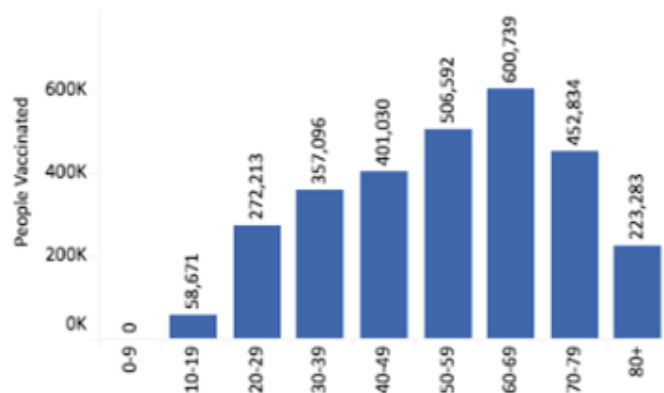

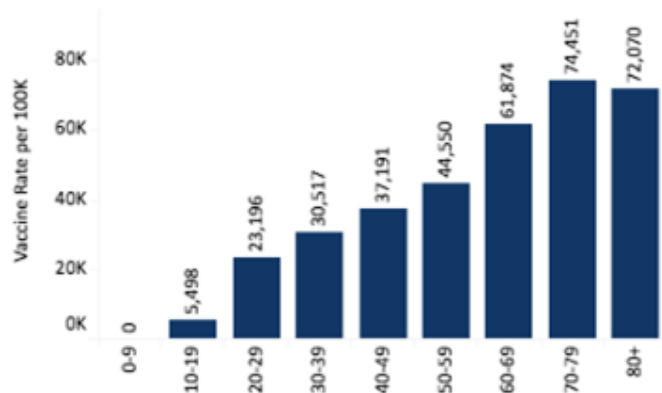

By Age Group

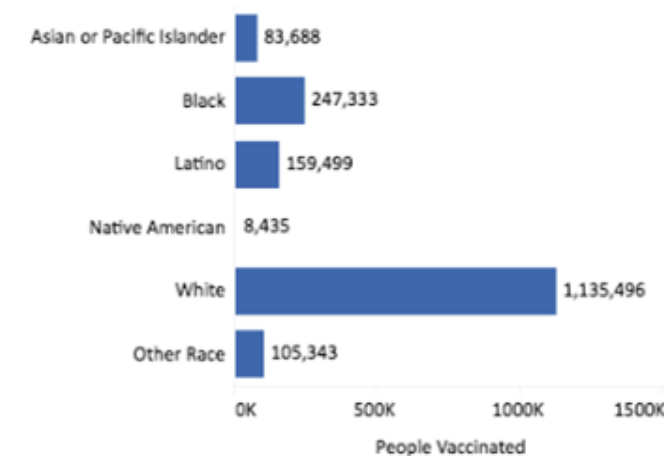

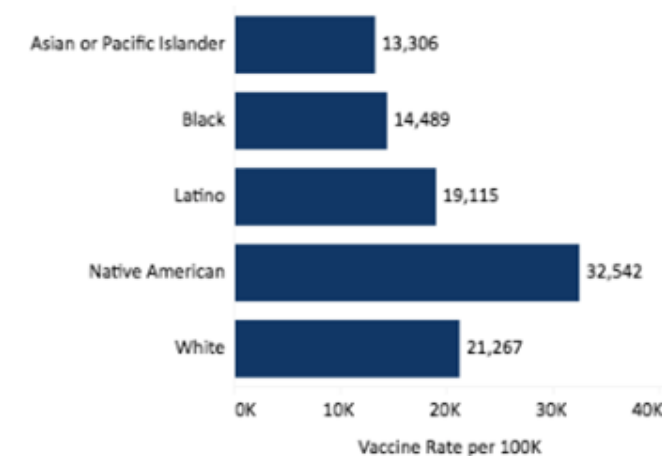
Vaccination Rate per 100,000 Population

## Strategy: Community Outreach

- In March, the VEST contracted with **Elite Business Strategies** to lead grassroots community outreach and organizing efforts around vaccination.
- Elite currently has 6 teams on the ground across Danville, Petersburg, Portsmouth, Hampton, and Prince William, Virginia.
- Over Easter weekend, Elite Business Strategies canvassed 2,500 homes in the Norfolk area.
- Elite is leveraging culturally-sensitive materials created by a second contractor, **Greene Street**, when canvassing in communities.

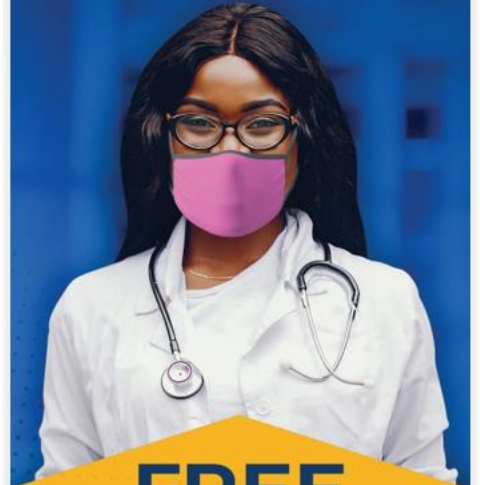

There's a lot of buzz about the safety of COVID-19 vaccines, but the fact is all three available vaccines are safe. The vaccines went through rigorous testing by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) before public distribution was authorized.

### THE TRUTH ABOUT COVID-19 VACCINES:



None of the FDA-authorized vaccines will give anyone COVID-19, regardless of age, gender, ethnicity or sexual orientation



The vaccines will not make you more susceptible to COVID-19. In fact it is the opposite—the two-dose vaccines are about 95% effective at preventing COVID-19



Authorized vaccines will never affect your ability to become pregnant or cause you to become sterile



None of the vaccines available and authorized by the FDA can change, alter or damage your DNA

## THE TRUTH ABOUT COVID-19 VACCINES



**FDA-authorized COVID-19 vaccines will not affect or hurt the fertility** or the ability to become a parent for anyone, regardless of gender identity, race or ethnicity.



**The vaccines will not cause sterility or contribute to sterility,** regardless of gender identity, race or ethnicity.



**FDA-authorized vaccines will not affect the DNA or alter the DNA of anyone,** regardless of race or ethnicity.



**The authorized vaccines will NOT give anyone COVID-19,** nor will they make anyone more susceptible to getting sick from COVID-19.

### MYTH #1

The COVID-19 vaccine causes fertility issues.



### FACT

The COVID-19 vaccine will not affect fertility. The COVID-19 vaccine encourages the body's immune system to fight the virus without affecting one's reproductive system.

### MYTH #2

I've already had COVID-19, so I don't need a vaccine.



### FACT

People who have had COVID-19 may still benefit from getting vaccinated. Re-infection with COVID-19 is possible, and being vaccinated could lessen your symptoms if you do get sick again.

### MYTH #3

COVID-19 vaccines were rushed, so their effectiveness and safety cannot be trusted.



### FACT

COVID-19 vaccines are safe and effective. Millions of people in the United States have received COVID-19 vaccines under the most intense safety monitoring in history.

### MYTH #4

The COVID-19 vaccine enters your cells and changes your DNA.



### FACT

The COVID-19 vaccines available to us do not modify your DNA — they are designed to help your body's immune system fight the coronavirus.

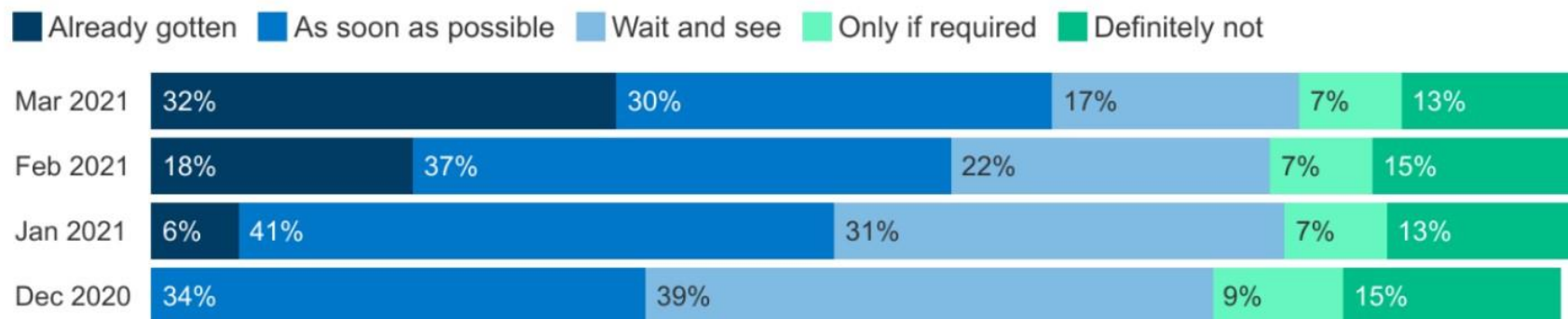




# Vaccine Hesitancy
