

COVID-19 Vaccination: Progress To Date














Equitable Vaccine Distribution






Vaccination Rate per 100,000 Population By Age Group



Strategy: Community Outreach

- In March, the VEST contracted with **Elite Business Strategies** to lead grassroots community outreach and organizing efforts around vaccination.
- Elite currently has 6 teams on the ground across Danville, Petersburg, Portsmouth, Hampton, and Prince William, Virginia.
- Over Easter weekend, Elite Business Strategies canvassed
 2,500 homes in the Norfolk area.
- Elite is leveraging culturally-sensitive materials created by a second contractor, **Greene Street**, when canvassing in communities.




