## 2024 Legislature

- All 140 seats were elected in November 2023
  - Democrats took House and maintained Senate majorities
  - Special elections 1 house, 1 senate
- It has been a bit slower so far than we usually see by this time in the year



## **Anticipated Topics – Behavioral Health**

- HB0037 Mental Health Loan Repayment Program (Clark)
- SB30 Budget Support for Behavioral Health Loan Repayment
  - \$1.5 Million proposed for continuation of the behavioral health loan repayment program; \$5 Million to enhance program for specific professions; two positions to help administer loan repayment programs (VDH)
- Right Help, Right Now Year 2 Legislative Priorities



### **Anticipated Topics - Healthcare Providers/Hospitals**

#### HB8 – Medical Ethics Act (Ware)

 Provides protections for healthcare providers, institutions, and payers to not participate in or pay for treatment that violates their conscience

#### HB32/SB35 – Implicit Bias Training for Providers (Clark/Locke)

 Requires implicit bias and cultural competency training for nurse and physicians to be added as continuing education in the regulations

#### HB87 – Drug Screenings for hospital patients with overdose symptoms (Green)

 When patients present with overdose symptoms, screen for marijuana, fentanyl, amphetamines, opioids, and phencyclidine as a part of any routine drug screening administered to a patient

## **Anticipated Topics - Maternal Health**

HB169/HB286 – Maternal Health Data and Quality Metrics Task Force (Keys-Gamarra/McQuinn)

Re-establishes the Task Force which sunset in 2023, annual report

HB204 – Maternal Mortality Review Team (Simonds)

access to DOC records for case review

SB140 – Fetal and Infant Mortality Review Team (Foy)

Establishes the FIMRT, triennial report



# **Anticipated Topics - Sickle Cell Disease in Adults**

#### HB239 – Advisory Council on Sickle Cell Disease (McQuinn)

 Establishes a new council to advise the Commissioner on the efforts to improve awareness of sickle cell disease and sickle cell trait and the needs of individuals with sickle cell disease; annual report

#### HB252 – Sickle Cell Registry (Mundon King)

 Determining means of improving the diagnosis, need for/means long term follow up; epidemiological analyses; rehabilitative programs; and assisting in the training of hospital personnel; other needs

#### HB255 – Adult Sickle Cell Screening (Mundon King)

 All adults will be screened at their annual wellness exam for sickle cell unless objecting on religious basis

## **Anticipated Topics - Miscellaneous**

#### HB33 - Microplastics in water workgroup (Clark)

 Requires a workgroup to develop recommendations on the reduction of microplastics in public drinking water

#### HB241 - Prescribed Pediatric Extended Care Centers (McQuinn)

 Requires creates and promulgation of regulations for a new licensure type for care centers

#### HB354 - Public Pools Regulations (Hope)

Requires promulgation of new regulations for public pools
