## DID YOU KNOW?

Fatal drug overdose has been the **leading cause of unnatural death** in Virginia since 2013.

**Naloxone** is a prescription medicine that **reverses opioid overdoses**.

It works by **temporarily blocking the effects** of opioids and **helps the person to breathe again**.

Participants will learn how to **safely respond to an overdose incident** and **reverse the effects of an overdose** utilizing Naloxone

All participants will receive **Naloxone, and fentanyl and xylazine test strips** at the end of the training, if desired.
