



Until Help Arrives Trainers

Goal/Mission:

To support the efforts of local public health offices by teaching Until Help Arrives curriculum to prepare citizens to provide aid and comfort to an injured person while awaiting the arrival of First Responders.

Responsibilities:

- Answer ALL alerts received from VVHS
- Complete the Until Help Arrives course, either on-line or in-person.
- Complete Train-the-Trainer orientation with Unit Coordinator
- Willingness to teach community and volunteer groups the Until Help Arrives curriculum, either virtually or in-person
- Work with Unit Coordinator to secure all the necessary support materials to conduct an in-person class
- Follow-up with the SWVA MRC Volunteer Training Coordinator after the class to return any materials, the course roster and time spent preparing for and conducting class
- Document all hours in [SWVA MRC Hours and Responsibilities](#)

Desired Results: To teach Until Help Arrives to SWVA MRC volunteers and community members

Expectations: Teach others to provide first care and comfort to those injured around them.

Qualifications:

- Approved member of the SWVA MRC
- Successfully complete Until Help Arrives
- Teaching experience is helpful, but not a requirement
- Ability and/or willingness to learn to manage technology, including ZOOM meetings. Personal laptop for in-person sessions

Time Commitment: For each class including preparation, class instruction and follow-up evaluation approximately 4 Hours per class

Location/Site: Wherever trainer is willing to travel within the SWVA MRC region

Supervision and Support: SWVA Unit Coordinator

Benefits: Development of teaching skills, providing support to local public health offices, professional skills development
