Dofficier Checklist for Community Testing events

Adapted from Long Term Care Facility check list

Donning

- 1. Gown, mask, face shield or goggles, gloves, hand hygiene station, head cover, and trash bin are all available.
- 2. Donning will occur outside patient area.
- 3. Remove any unnecessary jewelry and cell phone.
- 4. Tie up and/or cover long hair.
- 5. Shave off facial hair to ensure a good mask seal.
- 6. Hand hygiene for 20 seconds.
- 7. Don 1st pair of gloves
- Check gown for defects. No Defects. Don gown; extends over 1st pair of gloves. No skin showing.
- 9. Don face mask. Top strap to crown of head. Bottom strap to back of neck.
- 10. Mold mask to the face. Starting at the nose.
- 11. Check for a good seal by exhaling and feeling for leaks.
- 12. Don face shield or goggles.
- 13. Don 2nd pair of gloves. Ensure that they are pulled above the cuff of the sleeve.
- 14. Ready to enter patient care area.

Doffing

- 1. Begin Process in decontamination area.
- 2. Hand hygiene of gloves on for 20 seconds.
- 3. Doff gown. Rip off at shoulders and waist if disposable. Untie if necessary.
- 4. Remove gown inside out and roll off over hands until the outer gloves can be removed inside out.
- 5. Ball up gown and outer gloves and place them in the trash bin.
- 6. Hand Hygiene for 20 seconds on "inner" gloves.
- 7. Remove face shield or goggles.
- 8. Hand Hygiene for 20 seconds on "inner" gloves.
- 9. Leave decontamination area.
- 10. Hand Hygiene for 20 seconds on "inner" gloves.
- 11. Remove Mask: lean forward, pull bottom strap over the head, release, pull upper strap over the head, drop mask into trash bin.
- 12. Remove head covering if used.
- 13. Remove "inner" gloves; use technique to avoid touching skin surface
- 14. Hand Hygiene for 20 seconds.
- 15. Use sink with soap and water to scrub hands and arms up to elbows.

Note: if break for restroom, fluids or food must Don and Doff per above
