

# Updated Quarantine Recommendations for Vaccinated Persons

- On 2/10, CDC updated their [Interim Clinical Considerations for Use of mRNA COVID-19 Vaccines Currently Authorized in the United States](#) to include quarantine recommendations for vaccinated persons.
  - Vaccinated persons with a COVID-19 exposure are not required to quarantine if they meet all of the following criteria:
    - Are fully vaccinated (i.e.,  $\geq 2$  weeks following receipt of the second dose in a 2-dose series, or  $\geq 2$  weeks following receipt of one dose of a single-dose vaccine)
    - Are within 3 months following receipt of the last dose in the series
    - Have remained asymptomatic since the current COVID-19 exposure
  - Fully vaccinated persons who do not quarantine should still watch for symptoms of COVID-19 for 14 days following an exposure
  - Exception: Vaccinated inpatients and residents in healthcare settings should quarantine after close contact exposure
