Highlights of the week of 11/29-12/5

- 74,500 total kits distributed to libraries, as of 12/15
- 45 total libraries enrolled in the program, as of 12/15
- Libraries report handing out:
 - 2971 kits to community members the week of 11/21
 - 4207 total kits from 11/15-11/28
 - 8695 kits from 11/29-12/5
 - 18,912 kits from 12/6-12/12
 - TOTAL: 34,685

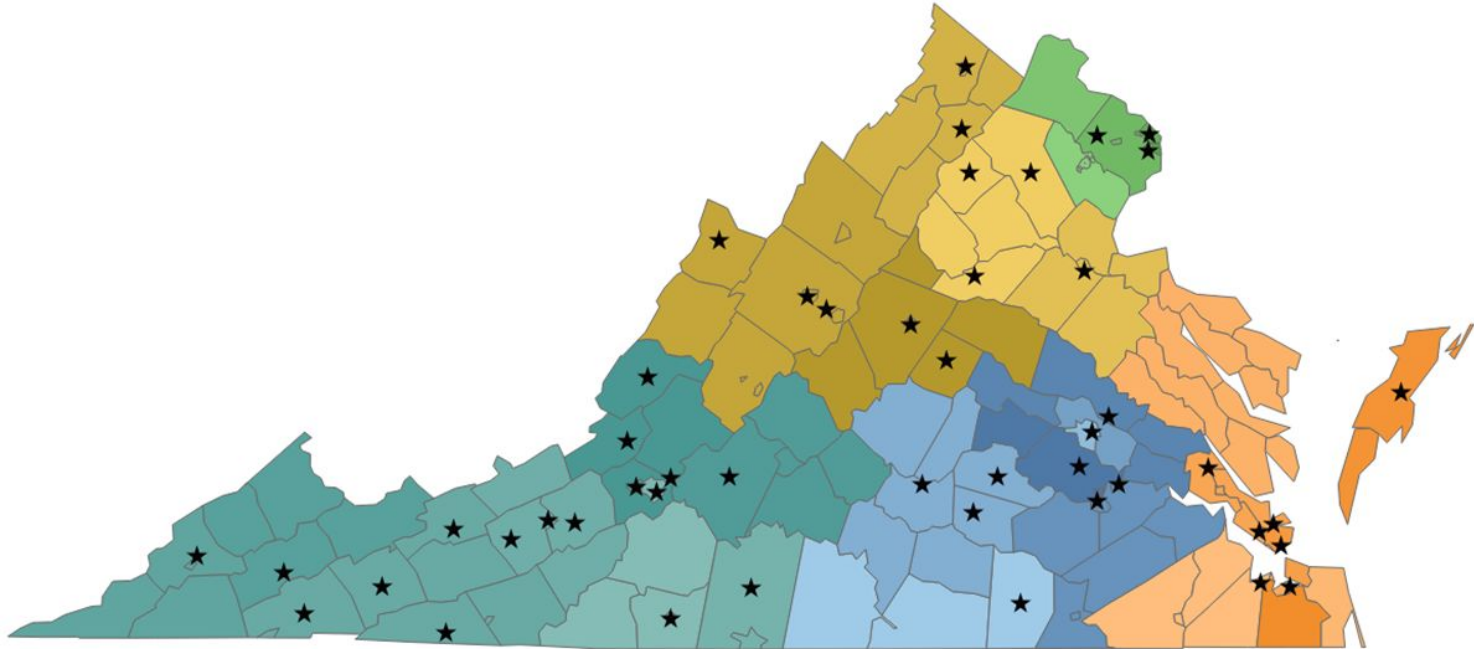

Key findings

- 6 libraries handed out their first kits the week of 12/6-12/12.
- 32 libraries handed out more kits the week of 12/6, compared to the previous week (71%).
- Several libraries report stocking out within a few days.
- Several libraries report distributing kits to families with school-aged children, in response to outbreaks/clusters in school settings. Representatives of LHDs for these libraries were notified.

Distribution of Participating Libraries

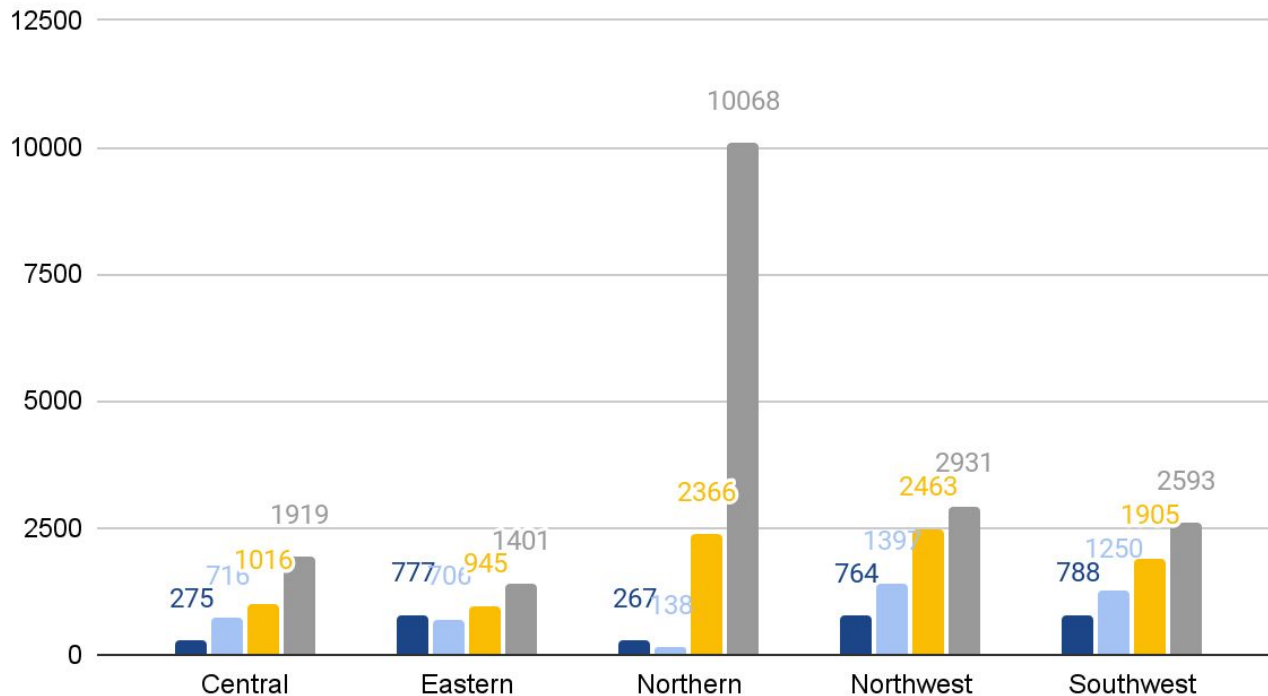
The stars in the below map indicate the locations of the libraries/library systems that committed to participate in the STACC pilot program. The map is color-coded by health district and health planning region.



Summary of reports from libraries - how many kits did they hand out?

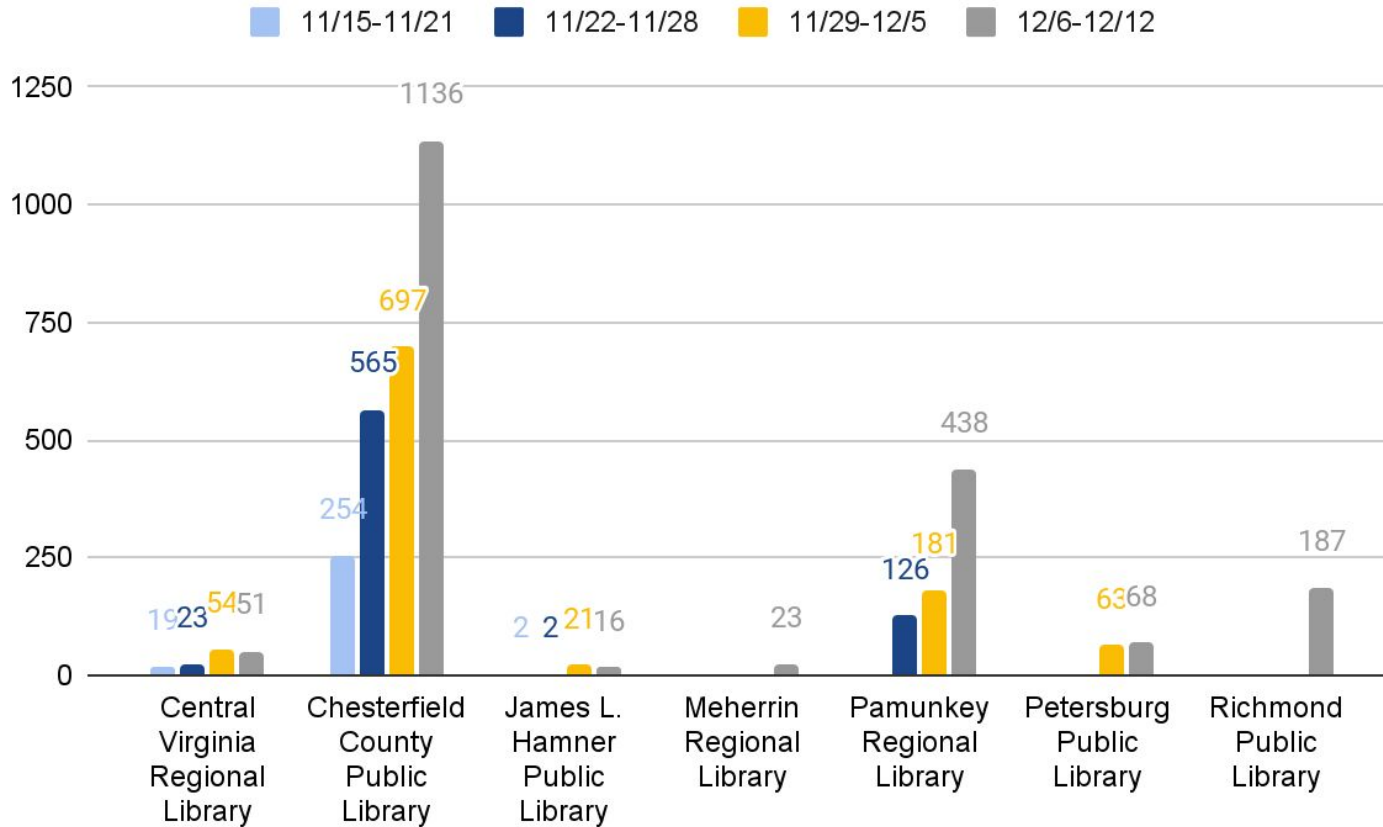

■ 11/15-11/21 ■ 11/22-11/28 ■ 11/29-12/5 ■ 12/6-12/12

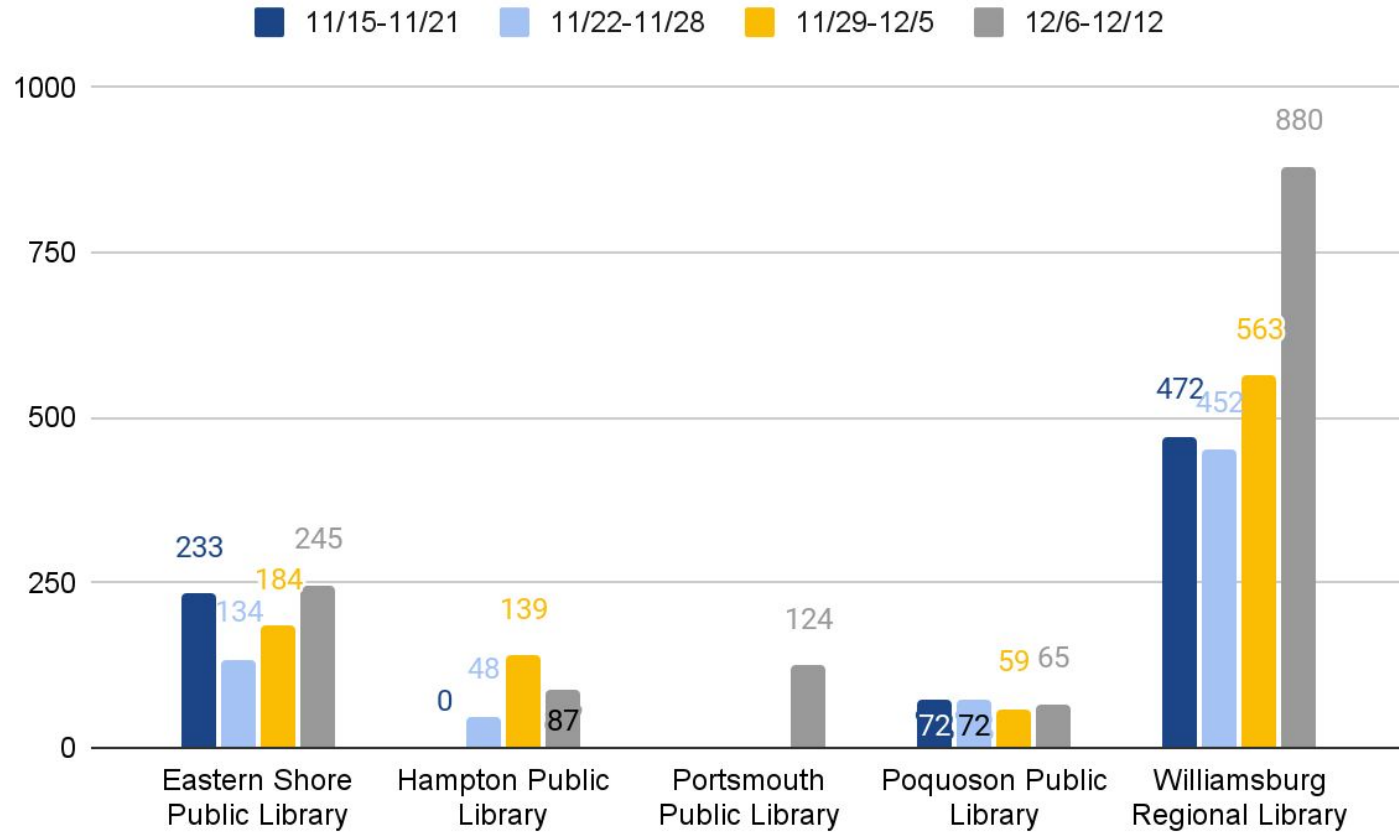

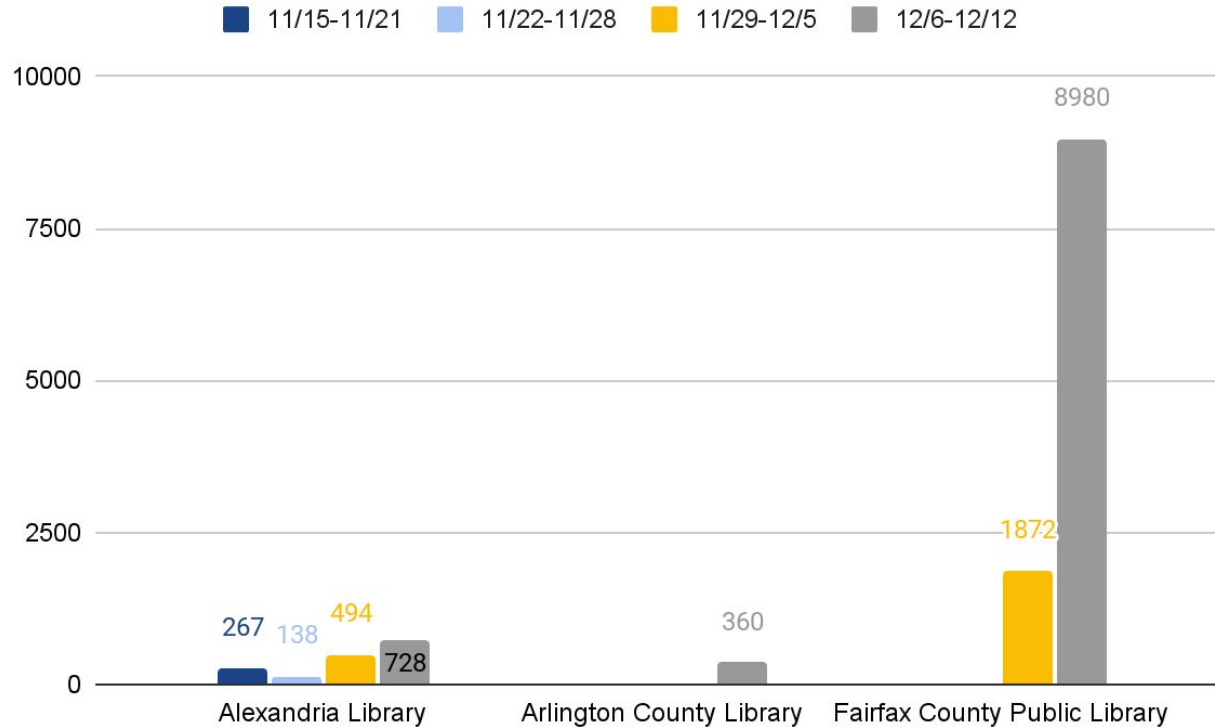
Test kits distributed by libraries - Central Region



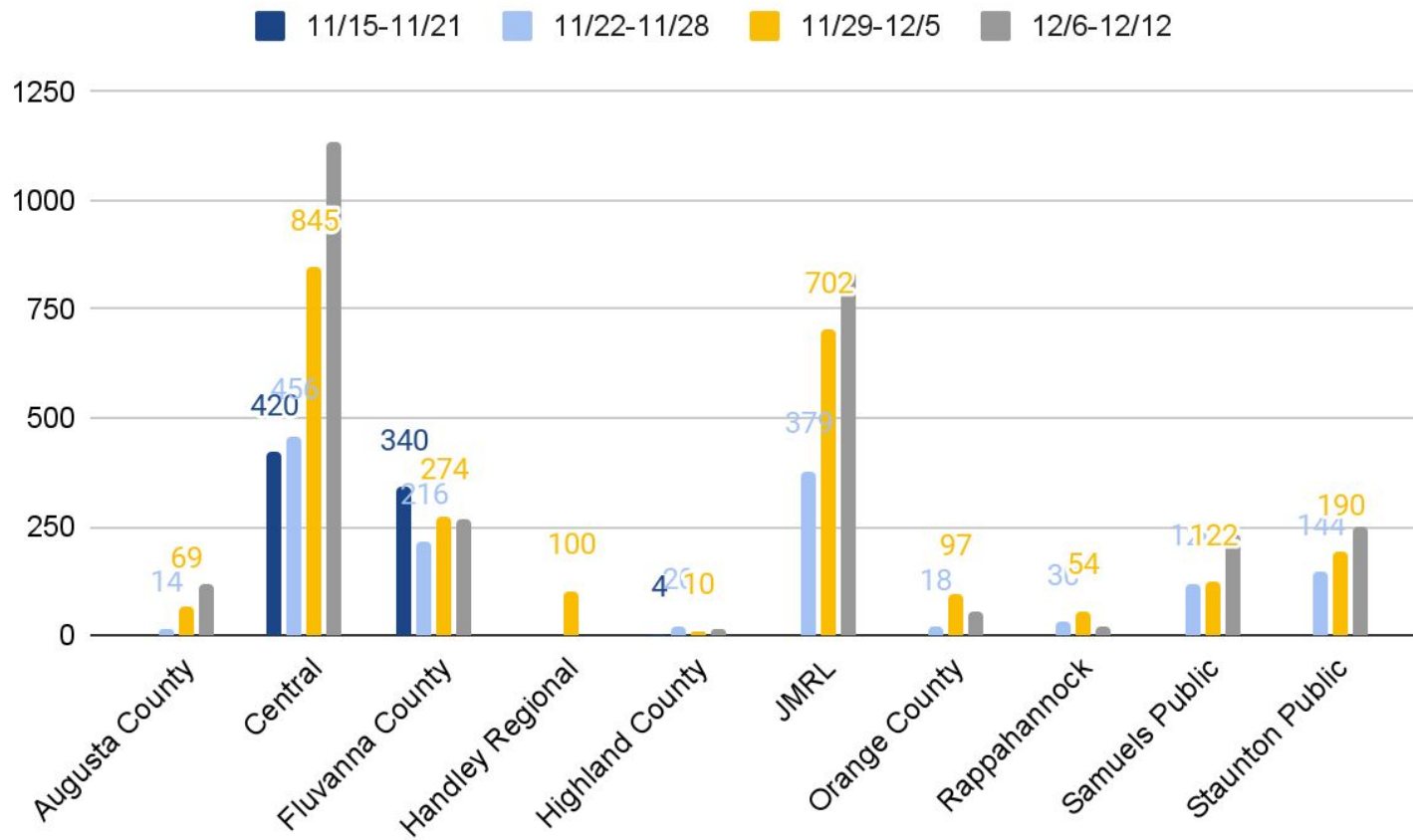
Test kits distributed by libraries - Eastern Region
