- NACCHO will go over that process shortly
- Both the form and 1<sup>st</sup> payment are due no later than October 28,2022
- In State application reviews will take place in May & June 2023
- Final Applications, 2<sup>nd</sup> payment, and final application forms are due to NACCHO no later than August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023

# In State Review

- Reviewer process will be expanded this year due to the combined cohorts in 2023
- Reviewers will have two months (May & June 2023) to conduct the review
- Reviewers will also have two (2) applications this cohort to review
- The reviewers will consist of state and local health department teams
- The local health department reviewers will be pulled from the districts going through the 2024 cohort
