

Executive Order 26

- Participate in Right Help Right Now initiatives.
- Develop a cost-effective plan to utilize and fund wastewater surveillance to detect the frequency, potency, and occurrences of fentanyl use in specific locations.
- Develop response strategy that includes a naloxone distribution plan.
- Develop public awareness campaign.
- Coordinate Local Overdose Fatality Review Teams.
- Participate in the Framework for Addiction Analysis and Community Transformation (FAACT).
- Reports Due 9/6/23



Senate Bill 1415

- Begin the development of a Commonwealth opioid impact reduction registry consisting of nonprofit organizations that work to reduce the impact of opioids in the Commonwealth
- Develop a comprehensive Naloxone Distribution Plan (VDH, DBHDS, DOC)
 - Provide plan guidance to localities
- Develop and provide EMS guidance on naloxone distribution to high-risk areas
- Reports due 9/1/23
