

- Training Education Exercise Division
  - EM / ICS Training
    - VEST Agencies & Localities
  - Exercises
    - Local, Regional, State
- Planning Division
  - COVEOP and Annexes
- Incident Management Programs
  - Program Management
  - IMT Training and Credentialing
  - Staffing & Process Support to localities and the VEST

# Commonwealth of Virginia Emergency Operations Plan (COVEOP)

- Framework for how the Commonwealth supports local governments, individuals, and businesses
- Improves capability to respond to and recover from disasters
- Emergency Management = Whole of Government responsibility
- Promulgated by Governor every 4 years
- Identifies roles and responsibilities of all Executive Branch State Agencies
- Identifies command and control
- Emergency Support Function responsibilities

## Executive Order 41 (2019)

- Governor Northam signed September 3, 2019 (updated from McDonnell administration)
- Reinforces COVEOP
- Directs Emergency Preparedness for All Executive Branch State Agencies:
  - VEST Liaison Officer (VLO)
  - Emergency Management Coordinator (EMC)
  - Public Information Officer (PIO)

# **Agency Responsibilities**



#### Have plans or procedures

- to implement assigned responsibilities in the COVEOP
- to implement assigned responsibilities in supplemental plans and annexes
- for response to and recovery from a natural or human-caused disaster

#### **Provide**

- assistance directly to political subdivisions during small, localized events
- personnel to the VEST to support ESF operations
- situational and incident-specific information to the VEST

**Identify** staff liaisons or points of contact to provide technical and subject matter expertise, information, and support

**Encourage and permit** employee participation in training and exercises related to their assigned emergency roles

**Promote** participation in the Adjunct Emergency Workforce Program

## Virginia Emergency Support Team


The mission of the Virginia Emergency Support Team (VEST) is to collaboratively respond to disasters and emergencies faced in the Commonwealth in an effort to best support all local, state, tribal, and territorial governments protect the lives and property of the citizens of Virginia.

- 300+ Trained Members 100+ State Agencies, Non-profit entities, and private sector partners
- Operationalize the Commonwealth of Virginia Emergency Operations Plan (COVEOP)
- Coordinate and support overall activities related to disaster response and recovery in support of local governments.
- Core management & administrative functions
- Information sharing upward (State Leadership), laterally (State Agencies/Local Governments) & downward (individual citizen).
- Bi-monthly Training and Exercise
- VESTEX & VOPEX








