(Lynchburg, VA)— The Virginia Department of Health-Central Virginia Health District, has some upcoming mobile options available for those seeking the COVID-19 1<sup>st</sup> dose, 2<sup>nd</sup> dose or booster vaccination. For the mobile events below, residents will have the option of receiving the Pfizer, Moderna or J&J vaccine. You can find links to pre-register at CVHD.org. Pre-registration saves time and secures you a time that fits your schedule, but is not required. Walk-ins will be accepted as well. Please bring your vaccination card with you if you have already been vaccinated with at least one dose.
