## Women, Infants and Children (WIC)

- For pregnant, breastfeeding, and postpartum women and infants and children under 5
- Provides nutrition education, supplemental foods, and breastfeeding support

## Infant and Toddler Connection

- For children from birth to age 3
- Tests for milestone performance
- Early assistance in reaching milestones

# Vital Records



- Birth, death, marriage/divorce certificates
- Process certified death records for funeral homes
- Vital records are available for **immediate family members only**
- Any person requesting a vital record must provide a **legible photocopy of their identification**
- Supplies applications for Social Security
- Provides out of state vital record information

# Community Programs

## BabyCare

- Home visiting program for pregnant women and mothers with children under the age of two
- A registered nurse will answer questions and help the mother work through any issues she has while pregnant or after the baby is born

## Child Passenger Safety Program

- From birth to age 8
- Education on proper car seat installment and child positioning
- Provides car and booster seats to those who meet income criteria

## Every Woman's Life

- Breast and cervical cancer screenings
- For uninsured women age 50 - 64 and women age 18 - 49 with health issues requiring diagnostic testing

## Partnering 4 Recovery

- Peer Support Specialist helps those suffering from mental health and/ or addiction and provides peer support services to two drug courts

## Community Outreach

- Subject matter experts from various departments will provide health education programs at offsite locations to meet the public's needs and connect community members to local resources

# Environmental Health

## Food Safety and Sanitation

- Inspecting and permitting of food service operations and training of food service employees
- Investigation of reported foodborne illnesses

## Private Well Supplies and Sewage Disposal

- Construction permits for wells and septic systems
- Owner assistance with operational problems
- Investigation of complaints and failing systems

## Hotels, Campgrounds, Migrant Labor Camps

- Permitting and inspection of facilities
- Investigation of complaints

## Rabies Prevention

- Investigation of potential exposures of humans and domestic animals to rabies
- Public education for rabies prevention

# More Community Programs

## Tobacco Cessation

- The INDEPTH program is an interactive program offers nicotine (including vaping) intervention and education for youth as an alternative to suspension

## Diabetes Prevention Program

- A year-long program for people at risk of developing Type 2 Diabetes that encourages healthy lifestyle changes to reduce their chances of developing it

## Epidemiology

- Prevent and control the spread of infectious diseases
- Keeps track of diseases in the community and provides advice to stop the spread of an infectious disease
