## **Employment**



People experiencing economic instability are more likely to experience chronic health conditions, disability, and premature death.

38.5% of all survey respondents reported that there were adults in their household experiencing difficulties finding or keeping work.

This issue impacted our Spanish speaking residents significantly more, with 64% of all Spanish language respondents reporting difficulty finding or keeping work.

## **Access to Transportation**

People who do not have access to reliable transportation are more likely to reschedule or miss appointments, which leads to delayed or missed care.
