

# PROTECT YOUR FLOCK FROM HIGHLY PATHOGENIC AVIAN INFLUENZA

- 1 Wash your hands well before and after handling your birds. If soap and water is not available, clean your hands with hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol.
- 2 Keep wild birds and rodents out of poultry houses and coops.
- 3 Clean, disinfect, and sanitize tools and equipment.



- 4 Do not eat or drink in areas where poultry live or roam.
- 5 Wear dedicated shoes in areas where you house and care for your birds.
- 6 Monitor the health of your birds. Contact your veterinarian or local extension agent if you notice any signs of illness in your birds.
