

PROTECT YOUR FLOCK

FROM HIGHLY PATHOGENIC AVIAN INFLUENZA

1 Wash your hands well *before* and *after* handling your birds. If soap and water is not available, clean your hands with hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol.

2 Keep wild birds and rodents out of poultry houses and coops.

3 Clean, disinfect, and sanitize tools and equipment.



Do not eat or drink in areas where poultry live or roam. **4**

Wear dedicated shoes in areas where you house and care for your birds. **5**

Monitor the health of your birds. Contact your veterinarian or local extension agent if you notice any signs of illness in your birds. **6**
