

In-home HIV Testing

What is an in-home HIV test?

Using an in-home HIV test kit is great way for you to find out your HIV status. This test uses an oral swab so needles or blood samples are not required. The kits come with English and Spanish instructions on how to perform the test and medical training is not needed.

Why should I use an in-home HIV test?

Sometimes you cannot access HIV testing or might feel very anxious about getting tested in-person with a doctor. In-home HIV test kits make it easy for you to know your status without having to see a doctor. The in-home test kit is much faster than traditional tests and your results are ready in only 20 minutes.

How much does HIV testing cost?

The health department offers both rapid HIV testing and in-home HIV test kits for free.

How does you get an in-home test kit?

The health department can mail in-home HIV test kits to anyone who needs screening and cannot otherwise access testing. You need to complete a quick survey over the phone, but no additional information is needed. You should receive your test kits within one week of placing the order.
