

# COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKER

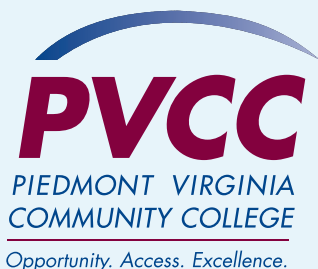
