- 1. We are pleased to announce that the MCHIP application has a new look. For your 2020, renewals please begin using the new application form. The PRA applications will be upgraded in the later part of 2020.
- 2. The **Annual Complaint form** for calendar year **2020** is required for all 2019 active MCHIP/PRAs. All annual complaints reports are due to both the **Office of Licensure and Certification** and the VA Bureau of Insurance (ombudsman@scc.virginia.gov) by March 31, 2020. - 3. All Triennial Reviews are postponed until further notice.
