Dear Commissioner Oliver:

Pursuant to Executive Order Fifty-Two (2020) issued on March 21, 2020, Carilion Stonewall Jackson Hospital ("CSJH") requests the Commissioner's authorization for a licensed bed capacity increase to serve additional patients during the COVID-19 pandemic emergency. Currently licensed to operate 25 beds, CSJH requests authorization to operate 36 or more licensed beds.


To expand bed capacity, CSJH will convert four private rooms on its medical/surgical unit to semiprivate rooms. CSJH will also establish five (5) private inpatient rooms in the Anesthesia Care Unit and two (2) private inpatient rooms in the Sleep Center. These rooms were formerly used as obstetric treatment and inpatient rooms; therefore, they are already equipped with oxygen and suction. Enclosed for your review are floor plans illustrating the proposed bed addition.

The proposed plan will allow CSJH to accommodate patients in a safe and effective environment of care. To the extent the proposed bed addition does not strictly comply with the architectural and design requirements set forth at 12 VAC 5-410-650, CSJH seeks a temporary variance to these standards in accordance with 12 VAC 5-410-30.
