In accordance with Chapter 4, Article 1.1 of Title 32.1 of the Code of Virginia of 1950 (the Code), as amended, I reviewed the application and all supporting documents submitted by HCA Health Services of Virginia, Inc. d/b/a Henrico Doctors' Hospital to add 16 inpatient rehabilitation beds at Parham Doctors' Hospital.

As required by Section 32.1-102.3B of the Code, I have considered all factors that must be taken into account in a determination of public need, and I have concluded that **conditional approval** of the request is warranted based on the following findings:

- 1. The project is generally consistent with the applicable criteria and standards of the State Medical Facilities Plan and the eight Required Considerations of the Code of Virginia.
- 2. A reasonable, less costly, more efficient alternative to the proposed project does not exist.
- 3. There is no known opposition to the project.
- 4. The applicant has adequately demonstrated an institutional need to increase capacity at Parham Doctors Hospital.

This certificate is valid for the period March 16, 2020 through March 15, 2021. The total authorized capital cost of the project is \$4,927,475.
