Temporarily add 382 Beds at Sentara Norfolk General Hospital in response to the COVID-19 crisis

Dear Ms. Edwards:

In accordance with Executive Order 52, I reviewed the request and all supporting documents submitted by Sentara Healthcare to temporarily add 382 beds at Sentara Norfolk General Hospital. I have considered the factors listed in my March 24, 2020, letter; and I have concluded that **approval** of the request is warranted based on the following findings:


1. Sentara Norfolk General Hospital has demonstrated that, due to the reasonable expectation of a sudden and overwhelming increase in acute care patients resulting from COVID-19 infection, Sentara Norfolk General Hospital has an immediate need to temporarily add 382 licensed inpatient beds.
2. Sentara Norfolk General Hospital's plan for training and shifting ambulatory staff is a reasonable solution for staffing the additional beds.
3. Sentara Norfolk General Hospital's plan and ability to obtain equipment and supplies is reasonable within the confines of the current crisis.
4. Sentara Norfolk General Hospital's plan to expand bed capacity in existing hospital space throughout the campus assures patient safety is maintained from a fire and life safety code perspective.

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In accordance with Order 52, the 382 added beds are deemed to be licensed from the date an emailed notice is received by Robert Payne, Director of the Office of Licensure and Certification, that they are open. This authorization is valid for the period April 24, 2020, through 30 days after the expiration of or rescission of Executive Order 52, as it may be amended.
