Temporarily add another 33 intensive care unit beds at Bon Secours St. Francis Medical Center in response to the COVID-19 crisis

Dear Mr. Accashian:

In accordance with Executive Order 52, I reviewed the request and all supporting documents submitted by Bon Secours St. Francis Medical Center, LLC to temporarily add another 33 licensed beds at Bon Secours St. Francis Medical Center (St. Francis) in addition to the 39 additional beds I authorized on April 13, 2020. I have considered the factors listed in my March 24, 2020, letter; and I have concluded that **approval** of this additional request is warranted based on the following findings:

1. St. Francis has demonstrated that, due to the reasonable expectation of a sudden and overwhelming increase in acute care patients resulting from COVID-19 infection, St. Francis has an immediate need to temporarily add another 33 licensed inpatient beds.
2. St. Francis' plan for training and shifting ambulatory staff is a reasonable solution for staffing the additional beds.
3. St. Francis' plan and ability to obtain equipment and supplies is reasonable within the confines of the current crisis.
4. St. Francis' plan to expand bed capacity in existing hospital space throughout the campus assures patient safety is maintained from a fire and life safety code perspective.
