**Re: Letter of Intent**  
**BRC Healthcare Virginia, LLC**  
**Establishment of Residential Treatment Facility**

Dear Commissioner Oliver:

You recently determined that the establishment of a substance abuse residential treatment center licensed by the Virginia Department of Behavior Health and Developmental Services (“DBHDS”) constitutes an “intermediate care facility established primarily for the medical, psychiatric or psychological treatment and rehabilitation of individuals with substances abuse licensed by the [DBHDS]” under Virginia Code § 32.1-102.1:3(A)(4) and therefore is subject to review as a “project” under the COPN Law.<sup>1</sup>

Consistent with that determination, I write on behalf of BRC Healthcare Virginia, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, to notify you of its intent to file a certificate of public need (“COPN”) application to establish a residential treatment facility for the treatment of individuals with substance abuse disorders with up to sixty (60) treatment beds, including up to twenty (20) detoxification beds and up to forty (40) residential treatment beds. The facility will be located in Goochland, Virginia, within Planning District 15.
