Dear Mr. Dreyer:

In accordance with Chapter 4, Article 1.1 of Title 32.1 of the Code of Virginia of 1950 (the Code), as amended, I reviewed the application and all supporting documents submitted by Inova Ambulatory Surgery Center at Lorton, LLC to add one general-purpose operating room.

As required by Section 32.1-102.3B of the Code, I have considered all factors that must be taken into account in a determination of public need, and I have concluded that **conditional approval** of the request is warranted based on the following findings:

- 1. The project is generally consistent with the applicable criteria and standards of the State Medical Facilities Plan and the eight Required Considerations of the Code of Virginia.
- 2. The proposed project would address the calculated deficit of general-purpose operating rooms in the health planning district.
- 3. The capital costs associated with the project are reasonable.
- 4. There are no reasonable, less costly, more efficient alternatives to the proposed project.
- 5. The proposed project appears economically viable in the immediate and in the long-term.
- 6. The Health Systems Agency of Northern Virginia recommended approval of the proposed project.



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This certificate is valid for the period July 8, 2021 through July 7, 2022. The total authorized capital cost of the project is \$1,335,884.

Please file two copies of the application for a certificate extension with the Department and one copy with the Health Systems Agency of Northern Virginia no later than 30 days before the expiration date of the certificate. Part VIII of the Virginia Medical Care Facilities Certificate of Public Need Rules and Regulations identifies the filing requirements and review procedure for certificate extension requests.
