Establishment of a Specialized Center for MRI Services Through the  
Relocation and Replacement of an Existing COPN-Authorized MRI Unit

Dear Commissioner Greene,

This letter is to advise you that Inova Reston MRI Center, LLC intends to file a Certificate of Public Need application on or before March 31, 2022 to establish a specialized center for MRI services with one (1) MRI unit at 450 Spring Park Place, Herndon, Virginia 20170 in Planning District 8 through the relocation and replacement of one (1) MRI unit currently located at 100 Elden Street, Herndon, Virginia 20170 in Planning District 8.

Please note that it may become necessary following COPN approval for Inova Reston MRI Center, LLC to cease providing fixed MRI services at 100 Elden Street and instead temporarily provide mobile MRI services at an alternative Planning District 8 location to ensure the uninterrupted provision of MRI services prior to completion of the new MRI imaging facility at 450 Spring Park Place. Should such a temporary transition to mobile MRI services become necessary, the mobile services would be offered at an alternative site within Planning District 8 because the existing Elden Street location is not configured to, and cannot accommodate, mobile MRI equipment. The COPN application will address this issue in detail.
