Dear Mr. Stallings:

In accordance with Chapter 4, Article 1.1 of Title 32.1 of the Code of Virginia of 1950 (the Code), as amended, I reviewed the application and all supporting documents submitted by First Meridian Medical, LLC t/a MRI & CT Diagnostics to expand MRI services with the addition of one fixed MRI unit.

As required by Section 32.1-102.3B of the Code, I have considered all factors that must be taken into account in a determination of public need, and I have concluded that **conditional approval** of the request is warranted based on the following findings:

- 1. The proposed project is generally consistent with the applicable criteria and standards of the State Medical Facilities Plan and the Eight Required Considerations of the Code of Virginia.
- 2. The capital costs are reasonable.
- 3. The proposed project appears economically viable in the long-term.
- 4. There is no known opposition to the proposed project.
- 5. The project is inventory-neutral and is more favorable than maintaining the status quo.

This certificate is valid for the period April 25, 2022 through April 24, 2023. The total authorized capital cost of the project is \$2,714,525.
