Please accept this letter of intent for Batch Group B/G – Open Heart Surgery and Cardiac Catheterization – for which the review cycle begins September 10, 2022 – advising you that Maryview Hospital LLC, d/b/a Bon Secours Maryview Medical Center intends, to file a Certificate of Public Need application to expand cardiac catheterization services. If approved, this project would be limited to the activation of the cardiac catheterization software on existing medical equipment at the hospital.
