Dear Ms. Smith:

In accordance with Chapter 4, Article 1.1 of Title 32.1 of the Code of Virginia of 1950 (the Code), as amended, I reviewed the application and all supporting documents submitted by James River Cardiology P.C. to establish PET/CT imaging services at the Colonial Heights location with 1 PET/CT scanner used for cardiac imaging exclusively.

As required by Section 32.1-102.3B of the Code, I have considered all factors that must be taken into account in a determination of public need, and I have concluded that **conditional approval** of the request is warranted based on the following findings:

- 1. The proposed project is generally consistent with the applicable criteria and standards of the State Medical Facilities Plan and the Eight Required Considerations of the Code of Virginia.
- 2. The project brings innovative technology to HPR IV not readily available or easily accessible for cardiology elsewhere in the HPR.
- 3. The project is more favorable than maintaining the status quo.
- 4. The capital costs are reasonable.
- 5. There is no known opposition to the project.

6. The project appears economically viable in the long term and short term.

This certificate is valid for the period March 9, 2023, through March 8, 2023. The total authorized capital cost of the project is \$1,001,700.
