**Expand Fixed Cardiac PET/CT Services to 3025 Hamaker Court, Suite 100, Fairfax, VA 22031**

Dear Dr. Webb:

We are writing this letter to inform you of our decision to pursue an additional Certificate of Public Need for a Cardiac PET/CT scanner at our other location at 3025 Hamaker Court, Suite 100, Fairfax, VA 22031 in Planning District 8.

Over the past two years, we have provided Cardiac PET/CT imaging for our patients at the Reston location. Cardiac PET/CT has proven to be a valuable tool in the detection of both mild and severe coronary atherosclerosis. The accuracy of Cardiac PET/CT when compared to older SPECT technology is far superior while exposing patients to dramatically less radiation. Furthermore, the addition of Cardiac PET/CT in Fairfax will significantly benefit our patients as it will provide greater accessibility.

The proposed project is separate from CCA's existing fixed cardiac PET/CT service at 1830 Town Center Drive, Suite 402, Reston, Virginia. It will expand access to advanced cardiac imaging for CCA's growing patient population and support the practice's planned addition of cardiologists in 2026 and 2027. CCA presently anticipates initiating the new service in fall of 2027.

We are certain that Cardiac PET/CT will continue to provide better patient care and outcomes, decreased costs, and enhanced patient satisfaction. Cardiac Care Associates will be involved in the interpretation of the studies, quality assurance, and the coordination and continuity of care for this program.
