Dear Alex Brings,

In accordance with Chapter 4, Article 1.1 of Title 32.1 of the Code of Virginia of 1950 (the Code), as amended, I reviewed the application and all supporting documents submitted by Maryview Hospital LLC d/b/a Bon Secours Maryview Medical Center establish a center for CT Imaging with one (1) fixed CT scanner at the Bon Secours Norfolk Emergency Center.

As required by Section 32.1-102.3B of the Code, I have considered all factors that must be taken into account in a determination of public need, and I have concluded that **conditional approval** of the request is warranted based on the following findings:

1. The proposal is generally consistent with the applicable standards and criteria of the State Medical Facilities Plan and the 8 Required Considerations of the Code of Virginia.
2. There is a deficit of nine CT scanners in the planning district (PD).
3. The proposed project can fill a gap in care for residents of Northern Norfolk.
4. There is no alternative identified to the proposed project and it is more beneficial than the status quo.


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5. There is no known opposition to the proposal.

This certificate is valid for the period February 16, 2026, through February 15, 2027. The total authorized capital cost of the project is \$23,826,209.

MEDICAL CARE FACILITIES CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC NEED

THIS CERTIFIES THAT Maryview Hospital LLC d/b/a Bon Secours Maryview Medical Center is authorized to initiate the proposal as described below.

NAME OF FACILITY: Bon Secours Norfolk Emergency Center

LOCATION: 155 Kinglsey Lane, Norfolk Virginia, 23505

OWNERSHIP AND CONTROL: Maryview Hospital LLC d/b/a Bon Secours Maryview Medical Center

SCOPE OF PROJECT: Establish a Center for CT Imaging with one (1) fixed CT scanner. Capital costs authorized for this project total \$23,826,209. The project is expected to be completed by October 31, 2027. This certificate is issued with the condition that appears on its reverse.



Pursuant to Chapter 4, Article 1:1 of Title 32.1, Sections 32.1-102.1 through 32.1-102.12 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended and the policies and procedures promulgated thereunder, this Medical Care Facilities Certificate of Public Need is issued contingent upon substantial and continuing progress towards implementation of the proposal within twelve (12) months from the date of issuance. A progress report shall be submitted to the State Health Commissioner within twelve (12) months from the date of issuance along with adequate assurance of completion within a reasonable time period. The Commissioner reserves the right not to renew this Certificate in the event the applicant fails to fulfill these conditions. This Certificate is non-transferable and is limited to the location, ownership, control and scope of the project shown herein.

This project shall be subject to the Bon Secours Hampton Roads Health System (BSHR) systemwide charity care condition attached to Certificate No. VA-04237, effective January 1, 2010 (currently 4%). Provided that the charity care provided under the BSHR system-wide condition shall be valued under the provider reimbursement methodology utilized by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services for reimbursement under Title XVIII of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. § 1395 et seq. BSHR will accept a revised percentage based on the regional average after such time regional charity care data valued under the provider reimbursement methodology utilized by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services for reimbursement under Title XVIII of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. § 1395 et seq. are available from Virginia Health Information. In addition to any right of BSHR to seek modification or adjustment described in the BSHR system-wide condition, to the extent BSHR expects its BSHR system-wide condition as valued under the provider reimbursement methodology utilized by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services for reimbursement under Title XVIII of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. § 1395 et seq. or any revised percentage to materially alter the value of its charity care commitment thereunder, it may petition the Commissioner for a modification of the BSHR system-wide condition to resolve the expected discrepancy.

BSHR will provide acute care services to individuals who are eligible for benefits under Title XVIII of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. § 1395 et seq.), Title XIX of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. § 1396 et seq.), and 10 U.S.C. § 1071 et seq
