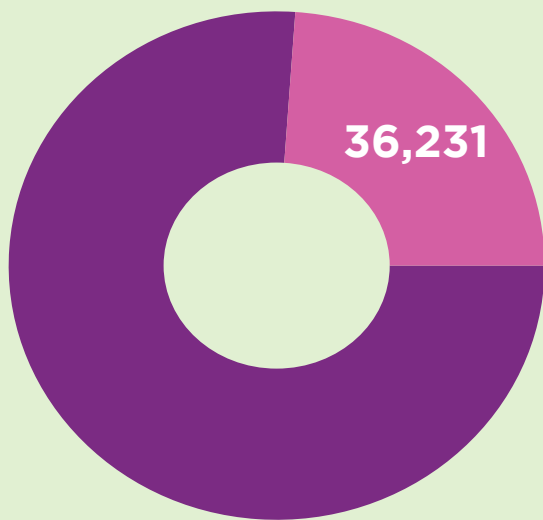

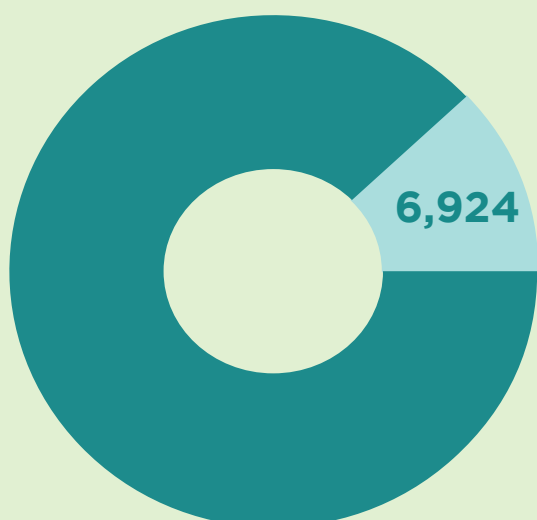


■ Breast Screenings Needing Additional Testing

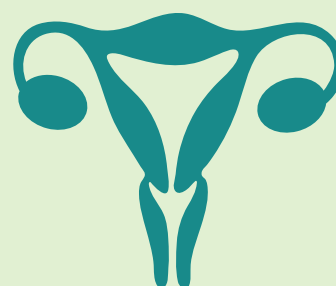


Diagnosed more than 2,400 Breast Cancers
