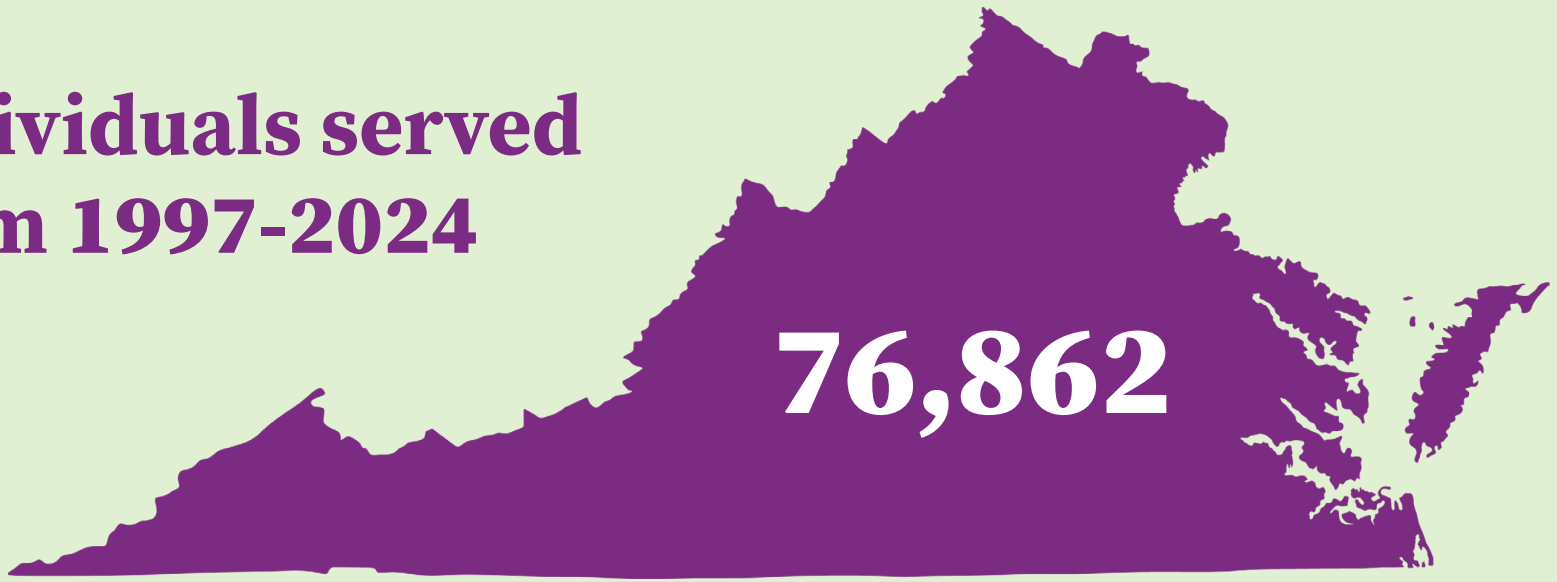


Every Woman's Life

A Virginia Department of Health Program

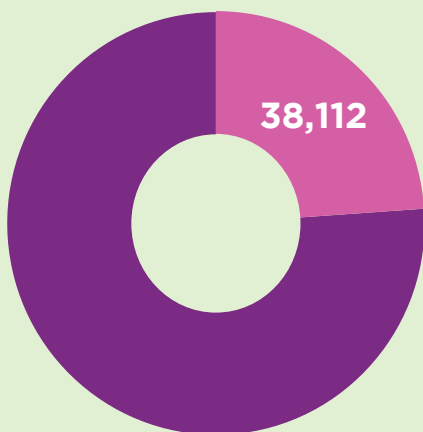
The Every Woman's Life program (EWL) began in 1997 with funding obtained from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. EWL provides low-income, uninsured individuals access to timely, high-quality screening and diagnostic services to detect breast and cervical cancer at the earliest stages.

Breast Screenings **154,157**

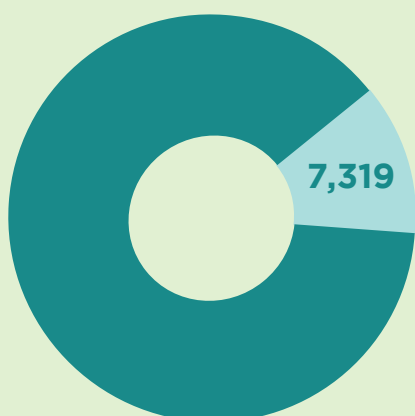


■ Breast Screenings Needing Additional Testing

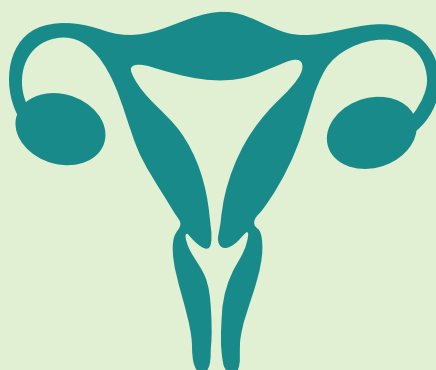


Diagnosed more than **2,500** Breast Cancers
