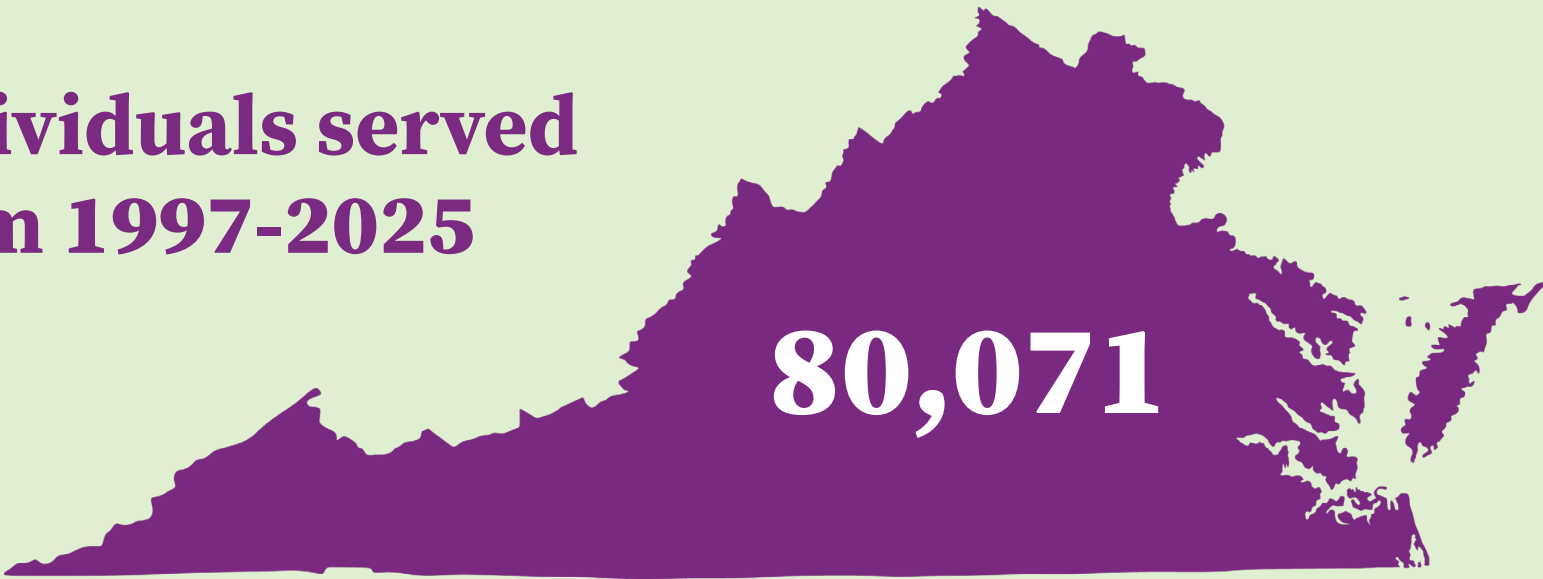


# Every Woman’s Life

## A Virginia Department of Health Program

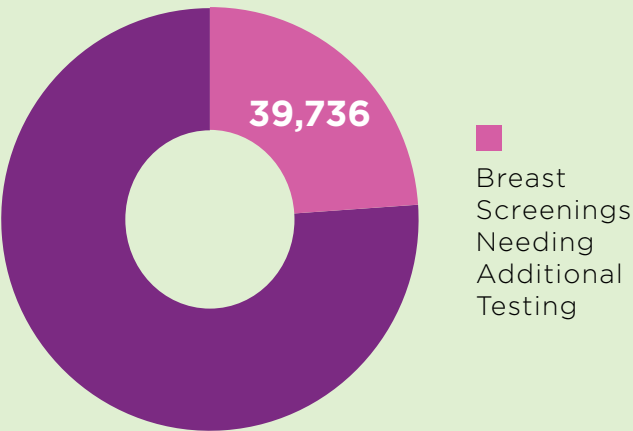

from 1997-2025



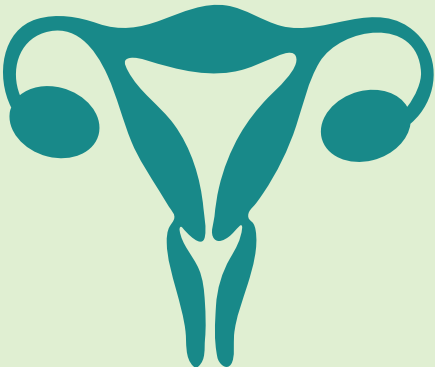
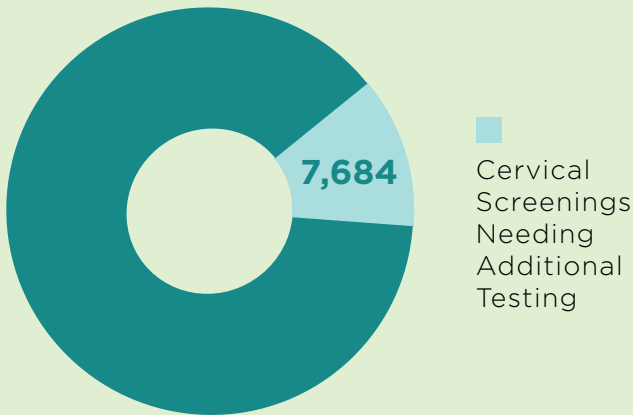
Provided more than 227,000 breast and cervical cancer screenings
